The Faculty of Law of the Comenius University in Bratislava would like to invite you to the international scholastic conference „Law as a unifying factor of Europe - jurisprudence and practice“ which will take place from the 21st until the 23rd of October 2010 in Bratislava. The conference is organized under the auspices of the President of the European Parliament, the President of the Slovak Republic and the Prime Minister of the Slovak Republic.



The main objective is to organize an international scholastic conference accessible to the wide legal scholastic community, to legal academics, as well as to practitioners of law, and thus to interconnect jurisprudence with legal practice and to provide an impulse for the resolution of current legal issues and problems, sound legal discussion and development of jurisprudence, legal practice and legal education.

Regarding the objective stated, the conference is divided into a plenary session and simultaneous sessions held within 12 individual sections, each covering a separate field of law, where attention will be given to specific current issues and problems of the given field.

Conference venue: Faculty of Law of the Comenius University in Bratislava, Šafárikovo námestie 6, Bratislava, Slovakia

Conference languages: Slovak, Czech, English, French (simultaneous translation will be provided)

Registration and abstract submission deadline: 12.09.2010 - only via the online registration system accessible at www.lawconference.sk

Full paper submission deadline: 07.11.2010 - template and instructions will be published on the conference web site www.lawconference.sk

Conference fee: 60 EUR (including VAT) - after registering for the conference the electronic invoice will be sent to your email. The conference fee is due by the date stated on the invoice and payment can be made by bank transfer only.

Accommodation: rooms in hotels near the conference venue have been booked by the organizer for conference participants - further information on accommodation can be found on conference web site www.lawconference.sk

Conference outcomes:

- 1) **proceedings of abstracts** published in paper form; all participants will receive a copy at the conference,
- 2) **reviewed conference proceedings** (ie, full texts of conference contributions in Slovak and English version) with an assigned ISBN, which will be issued on CD in electronic form; will be delivered by post to every participant free of charge),
- 3) **reviewed conference proceedings from individual sections** (full texts) published in paper form; will be available for purchase for special price.

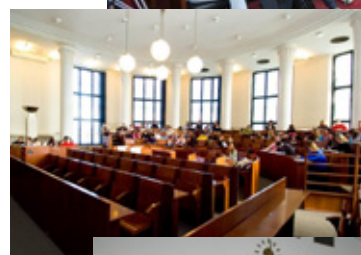
Basic schedule:
