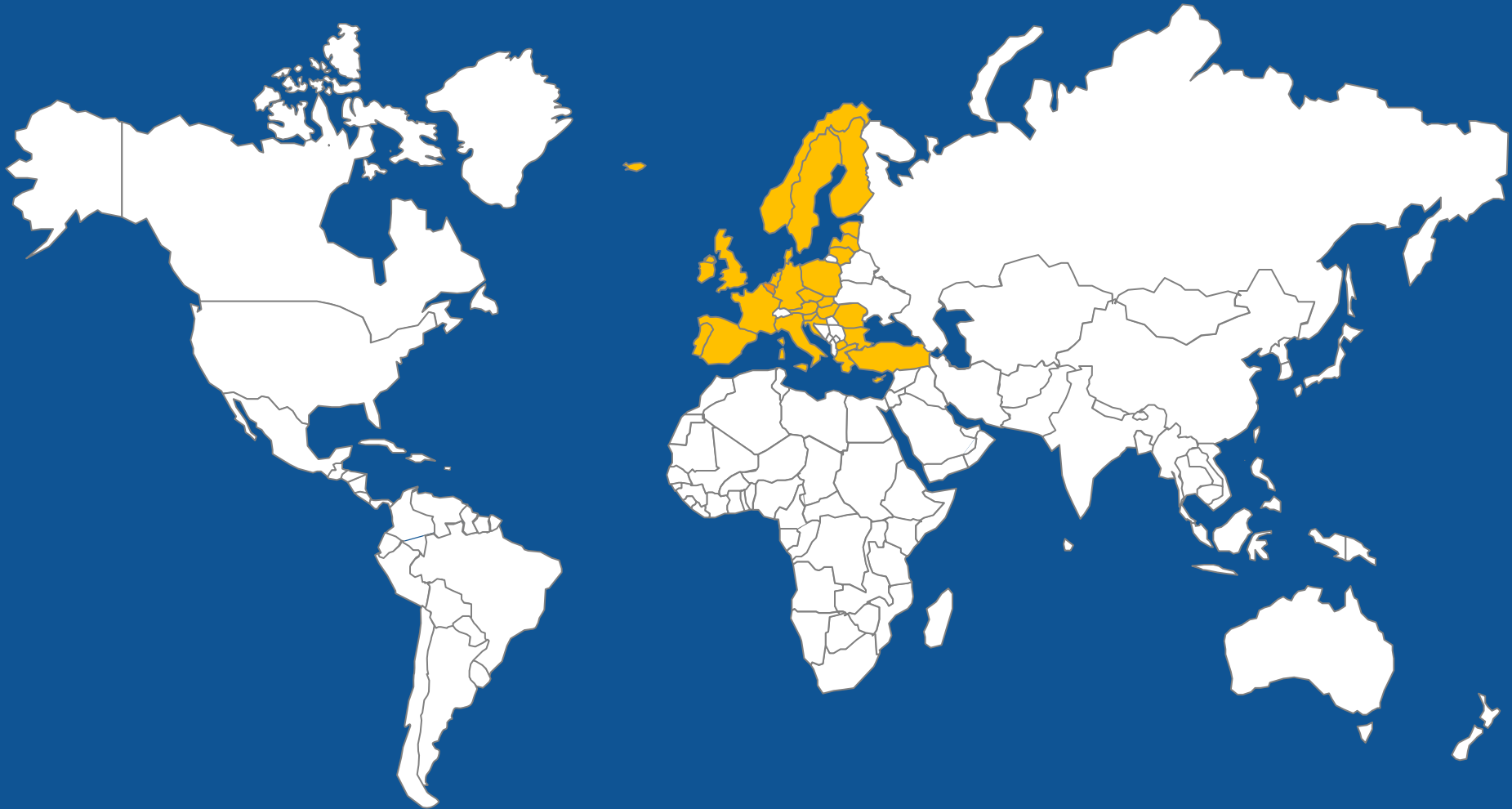

- Supporting learners and staff in their academic, professional and personal development
- Promoting internationalisation at home and abroad
- Enhancing the quality and relevance of higher education
- Catalyst for higher education reform

# How ICM works

- Key Action 1 of the Erasmus+: Learning mobility of individuals
- Short-term mobility for students (3-12 months) & staff (5-60 days)
- Mobility for Bachelor's, Master's, PhD & academic staff
- Inter-institutional agreements between HEIs from Programme & Partner Countries

# What ICM is not

## Not a simple follow-up of Erasmus Mundus - Action 2

- international consortia → inter-institutional agreements
- centralised → decentralised management (NAs)

## Not a "pure" extension of intra-European Erasmus

- Reflecting EU external policy priorities
- European universities manage outgoing and incoming mobilities

# EU funding

- Total ICM budget (2015-20): EUR 761.3 M
- Funding provides:
  - Organisational support grant for participating institutions (€350 up to 100 participants, then €250)
  - Individual support for students (€650-850/month) and staff (€100-160/day)
  - Travel costs based on distance (€180-1100)



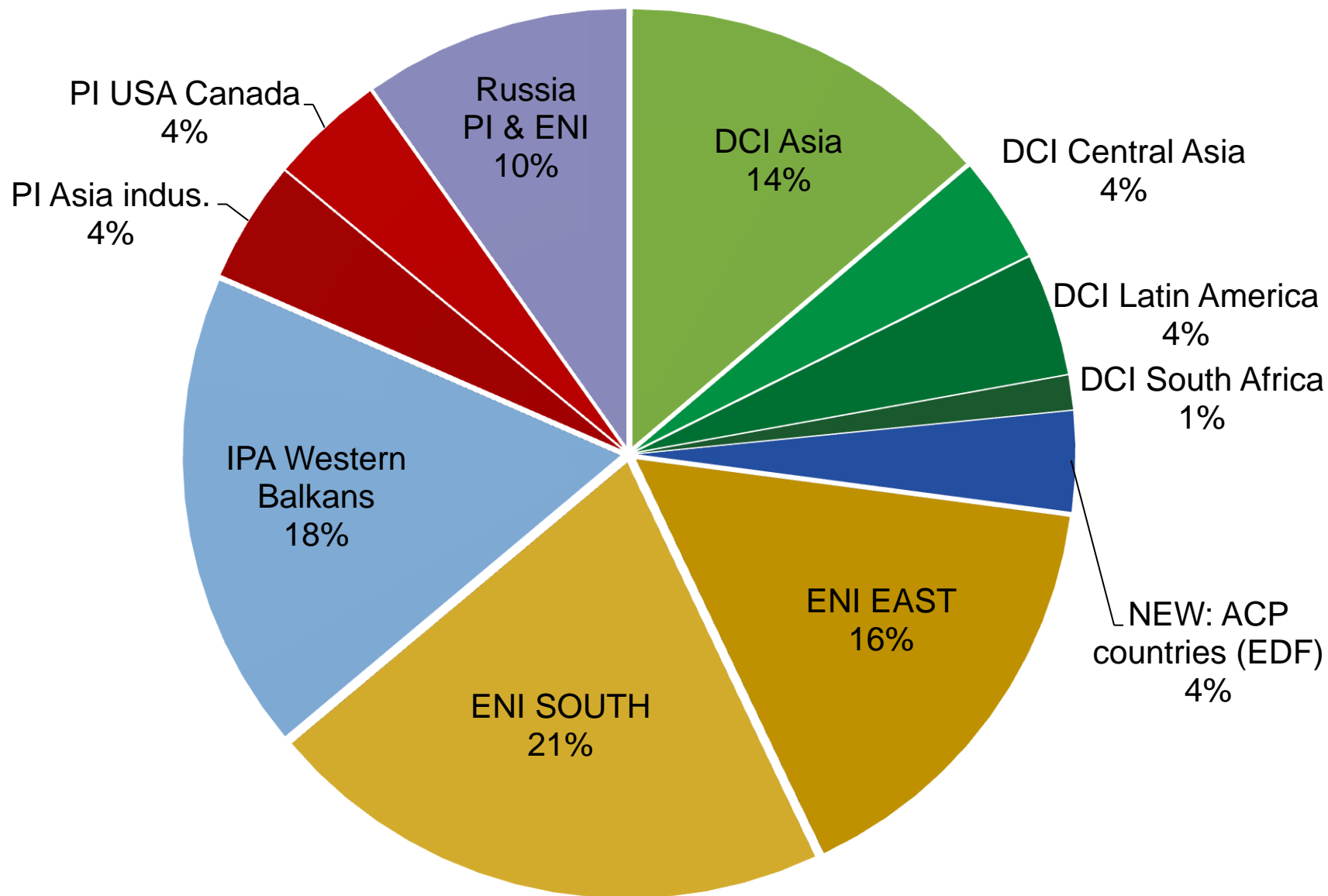
# Funding Instruments



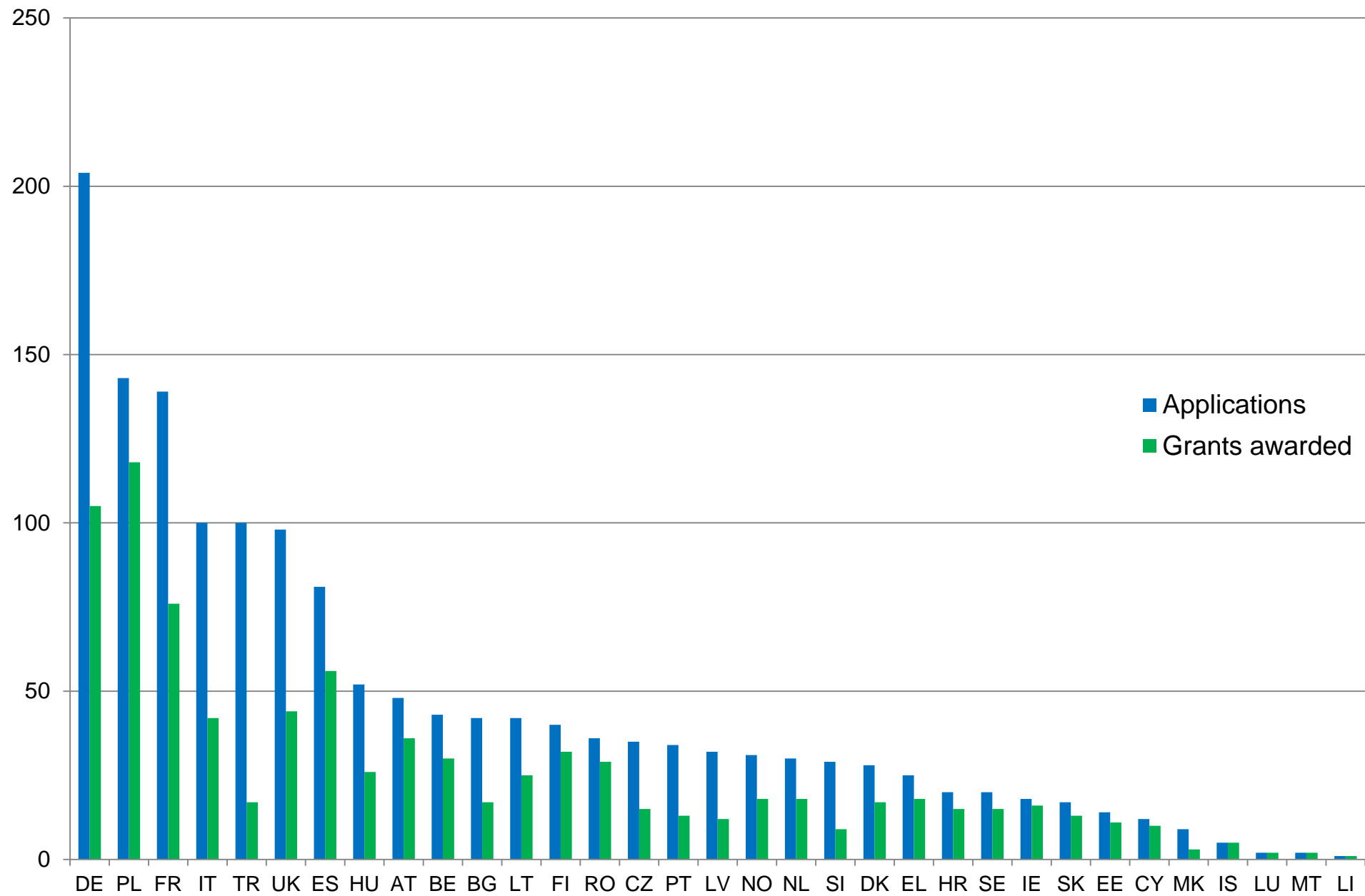
Different regions = different funding instruments

# Budget split by envelope

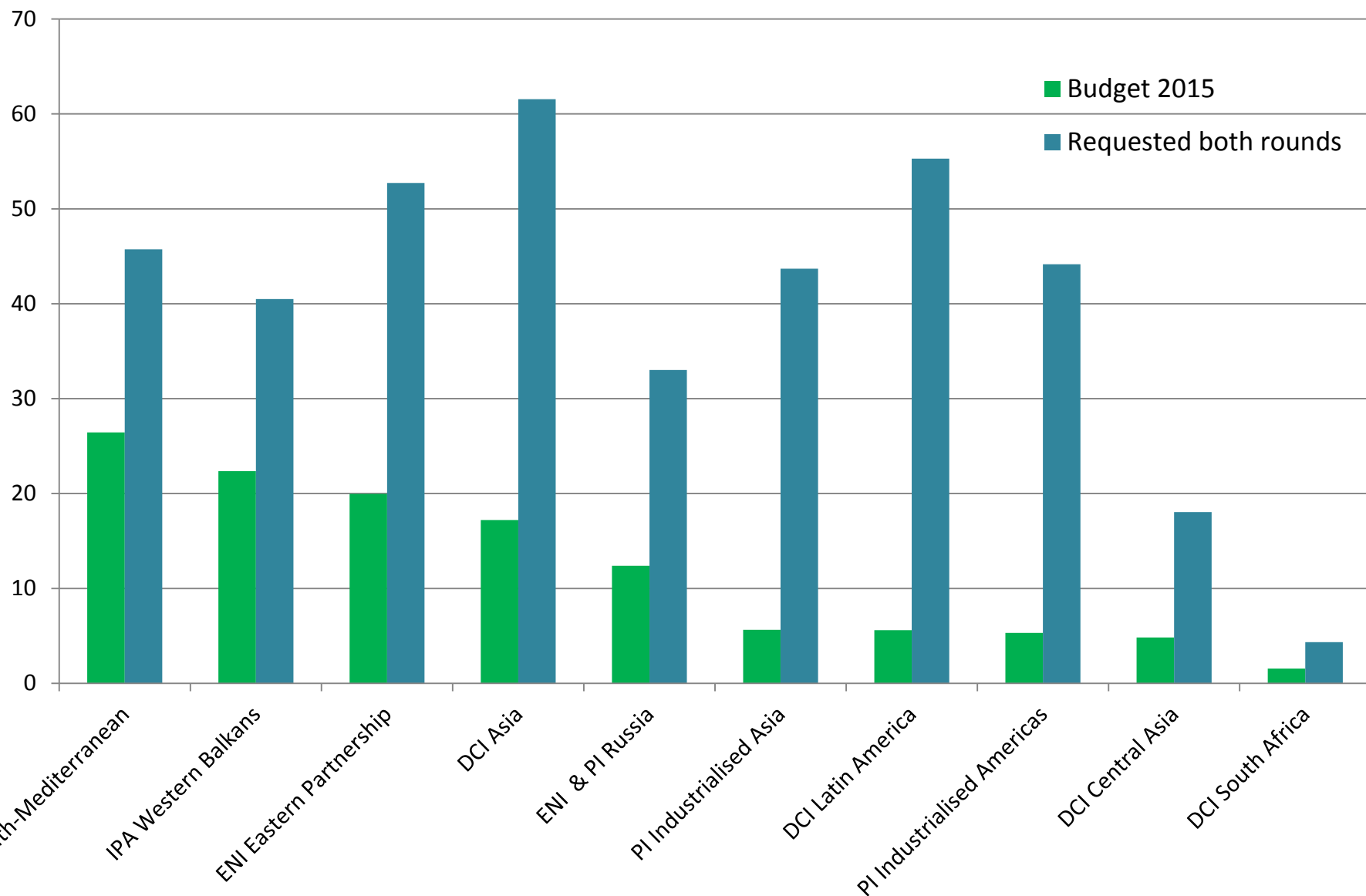
## 2016 budget for ICM: EUR 129 million



## ICM 2015: applications received and grants awarded

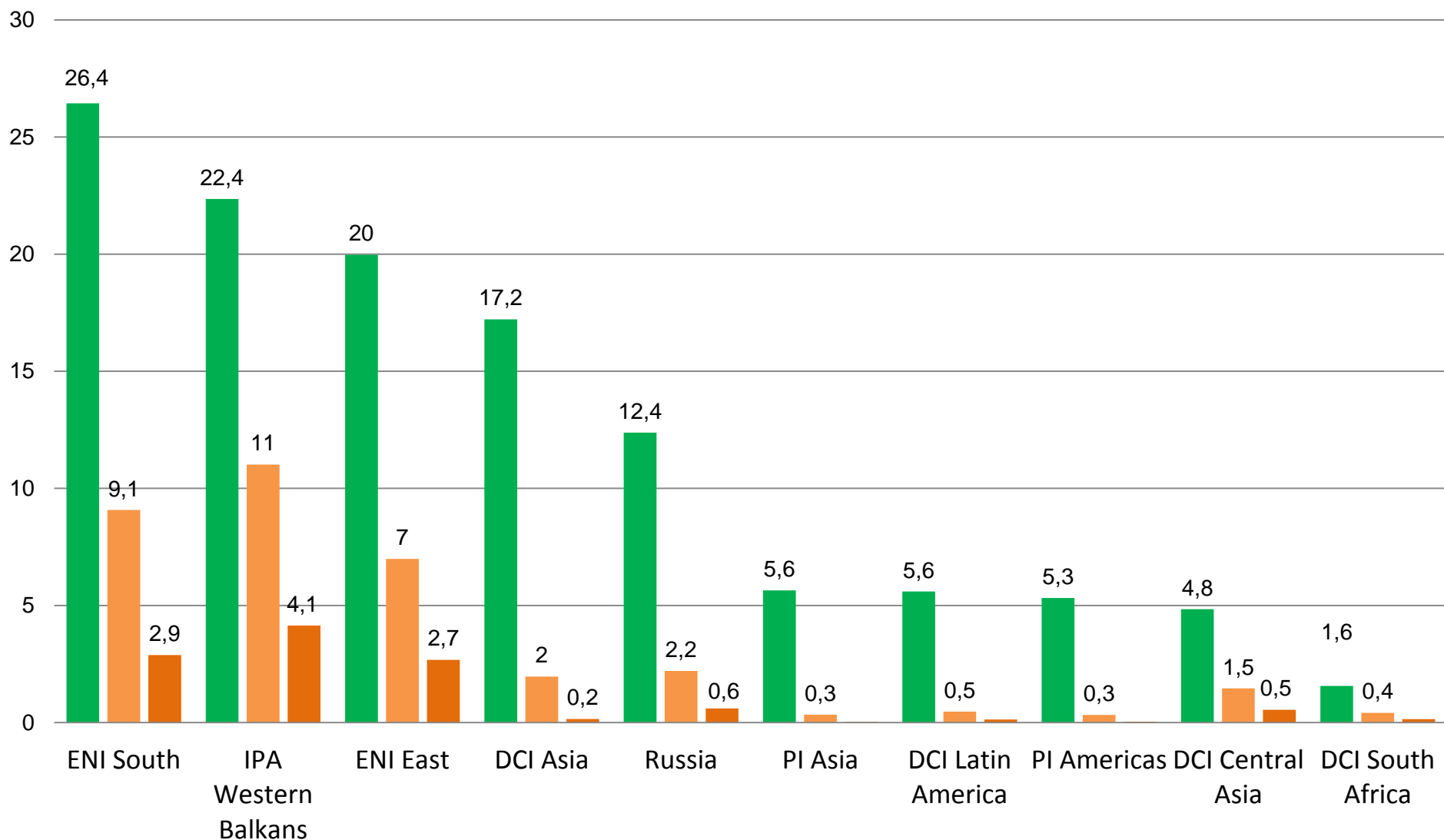


## ICM 2015: Budget available and grant requested (in millions of euros)

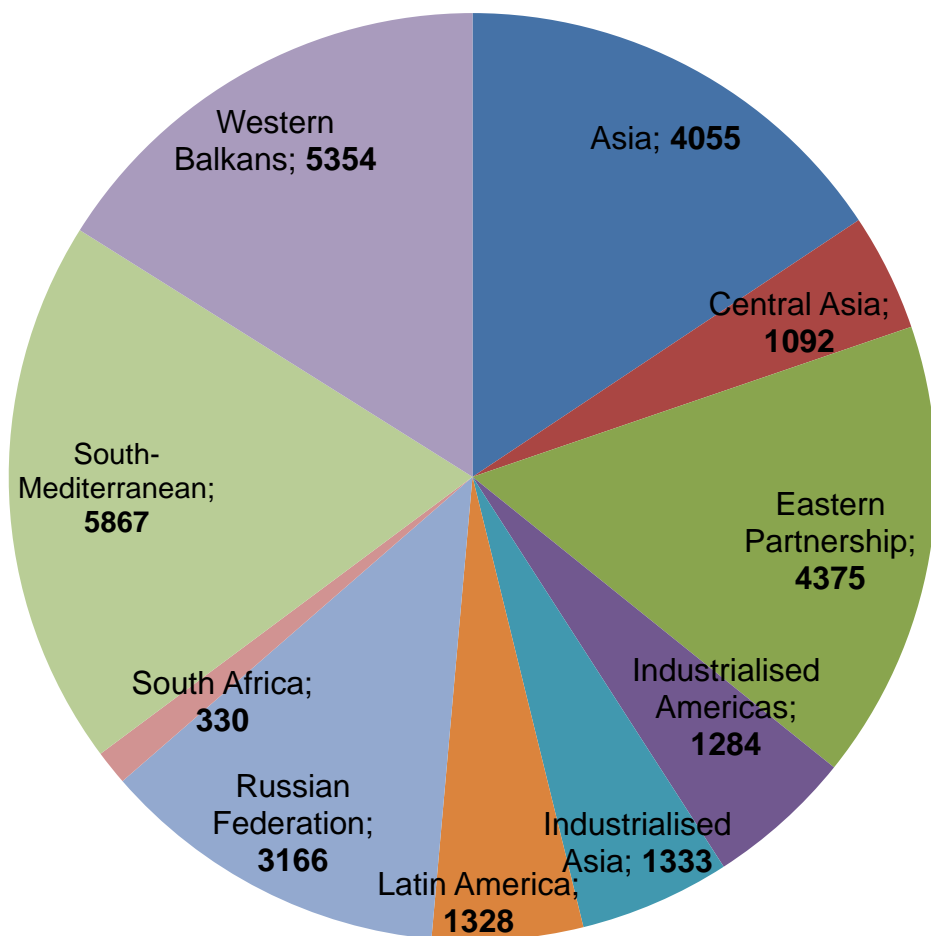


## 2015 ICM budget consumption by envelope (in millions of euros)

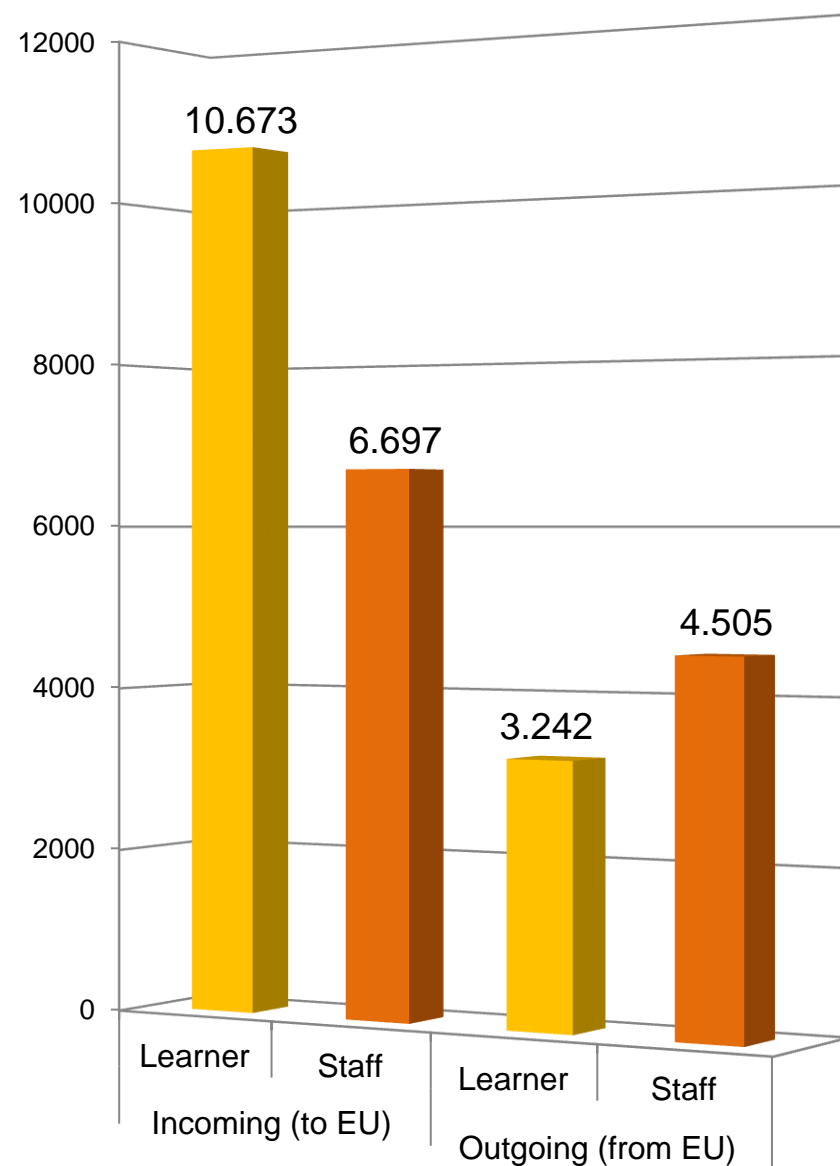
■ Budget 2015 : €121 million   ■ Available after Round 1: €34 million   ■ Remaining after both rounds: €11 million



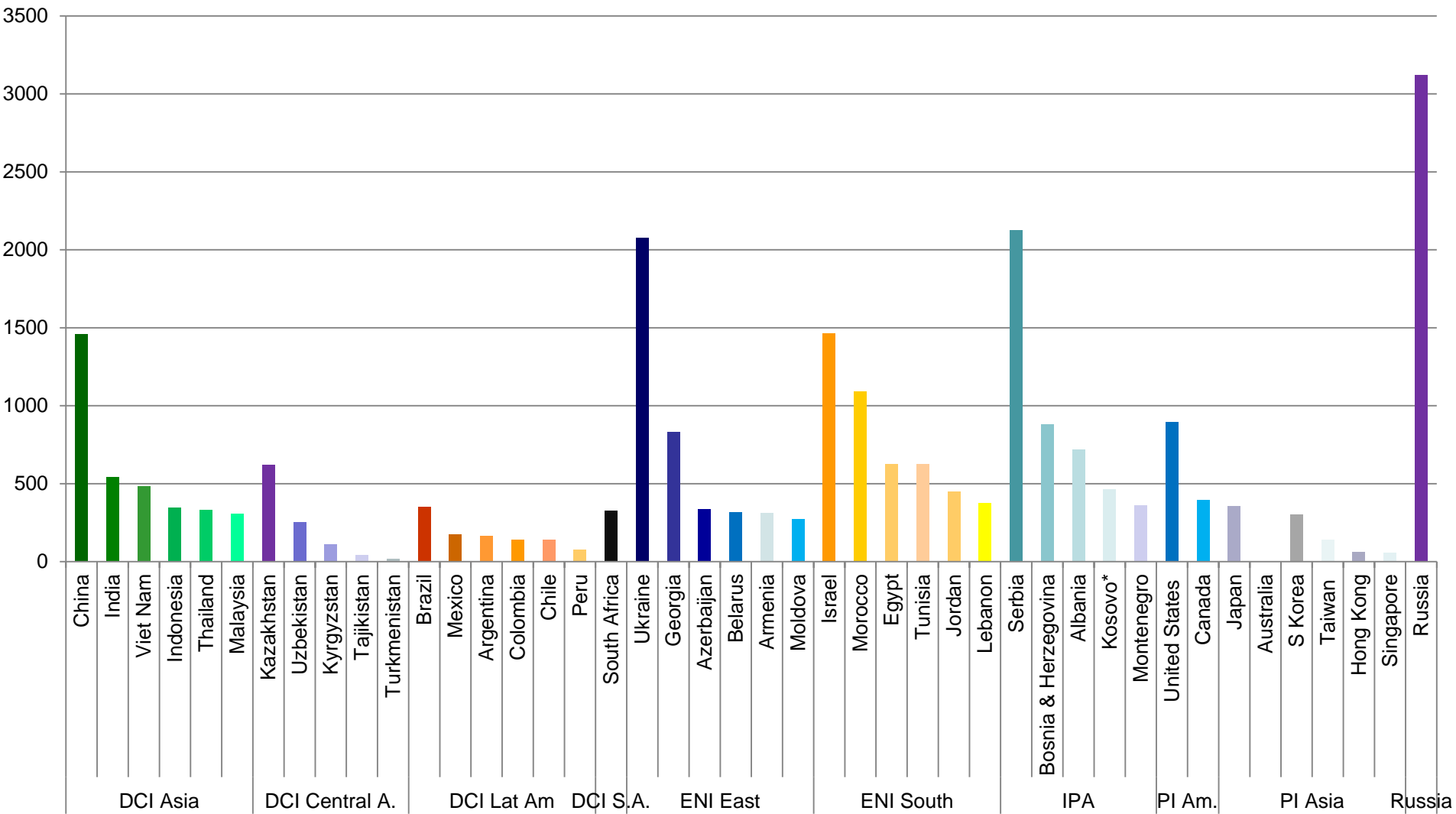
**Total mobilities (incoming and outgoing)  
per region**



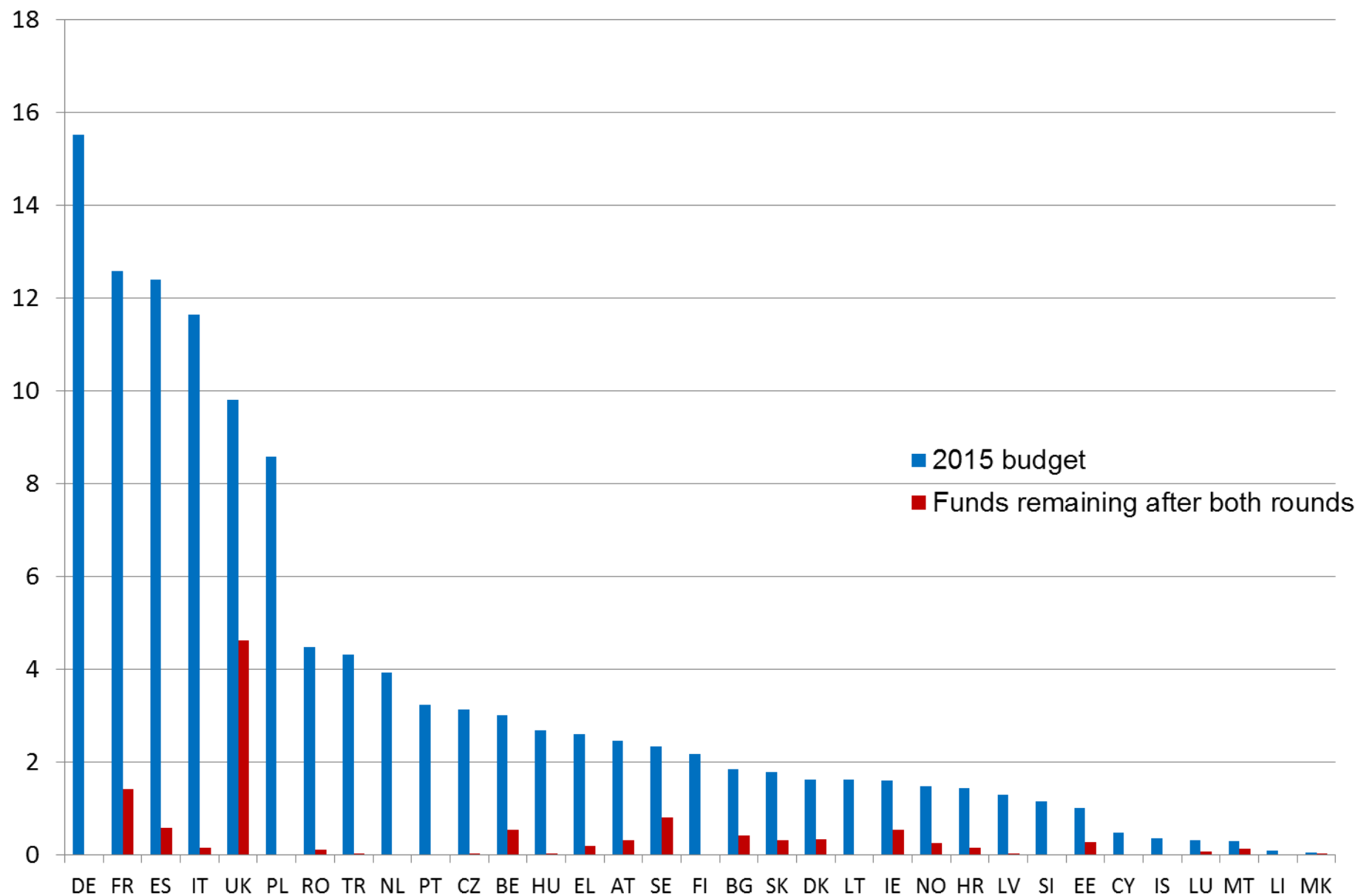

## Since 2016 Call for proposals

- ACP countries are now included
- Minimum score threshold for funding lowered to 60/100
- All restrictions on ENI East & ENI South have been lifted

## Next Call – recommendations

- Check the eligibility criteria
- Respect national & regional priorities
- Mobilise new partners, outside of the big cities
- Innovate content and methodologies
- Involve and empower Partner Country partners (recognised HEI) from the start
- Cover all dimensions of the project when preparing the proposal

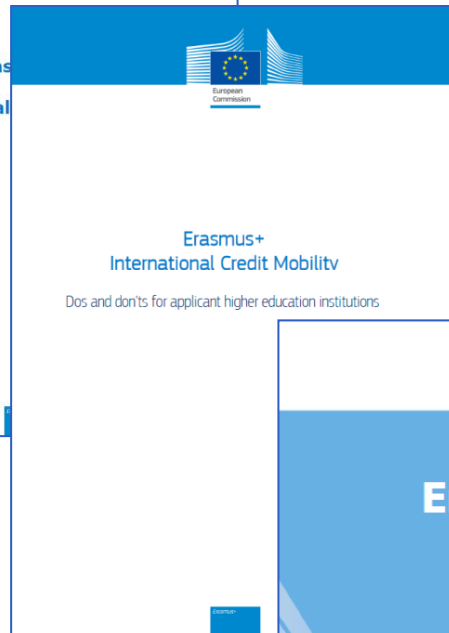

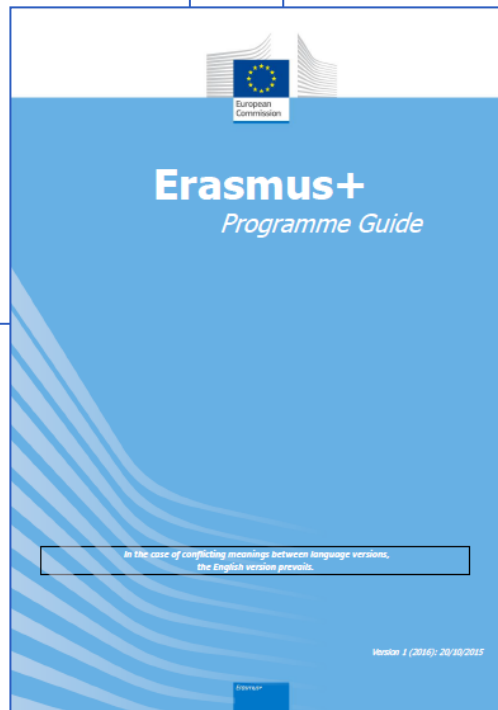
