- Survey was distributed to all UNICA members
- 10 questions were designed to better understand the scope of sustainability management within member universities
- Questions concern...
 - governance aspects of sustainability management (mission statement, management and reporting systems, duties & responsibilities)
 - key activities (research, teaching, transfer, campus)
 - best practice examples & potential benefits for UNICA members
 - memberships in other international networks
 - communication & participatory strategies

50 percent of UNICA


- Members of Sustainability Unit (10)

- Members of facility management or communication team (4)




73% of respondents have a mission statement regarding its strategy for sustainability or environmental protection



60 percent of respondents are publishing Sustainability Reports

Two thirds of respondents have a designated unit for sustainability management




Representing Sustainability The Outcome

Respondents indicated that sustainability in research and sustainability on campus are well represented. Sustainability in teaching and in international networking is neither strongly nor weakly represented, while outreach activities are rather weakly represented.






