#### **Status Quo**

- Approx. 2500 international PhD students enrolled (Visiting and degree seeking students outside a programme)
- Currently no services offered <u>especially</u> for international doctoral candidates
- To foster internationalisation these services are of importance

- a) Harder access to information
- b) Bureaucracy
- c) Missing social network

#### Hard access to information


- Initial information Center for Doctoral Studies not in the focus!


#### How challenging were following issues for you?






# **Missing Social Network**
