Foreign Scholars Invited to Teach/Research in South Korea

As a way to increase the quality and enhance the international rankings of South Korean higher education, the government has funded a new initiative to invite foreign scholars to teach at Korean institutions. [Korea Times](#) reports that the new program, [World Class Universities](#), will spend over 15 million U.S. dollars next year to invite 81 foreign scholars to teach and conduct research. Nine of the 81 scholars are Nobel Laureates. [The Chronicle of Higher Education](#) explains the World Class Universities program in more detail, "Begun in January, the five-year plan finances collaborative projects between overseas and South Korean scholars working to establish academic programs in fields that would support economic growth."
