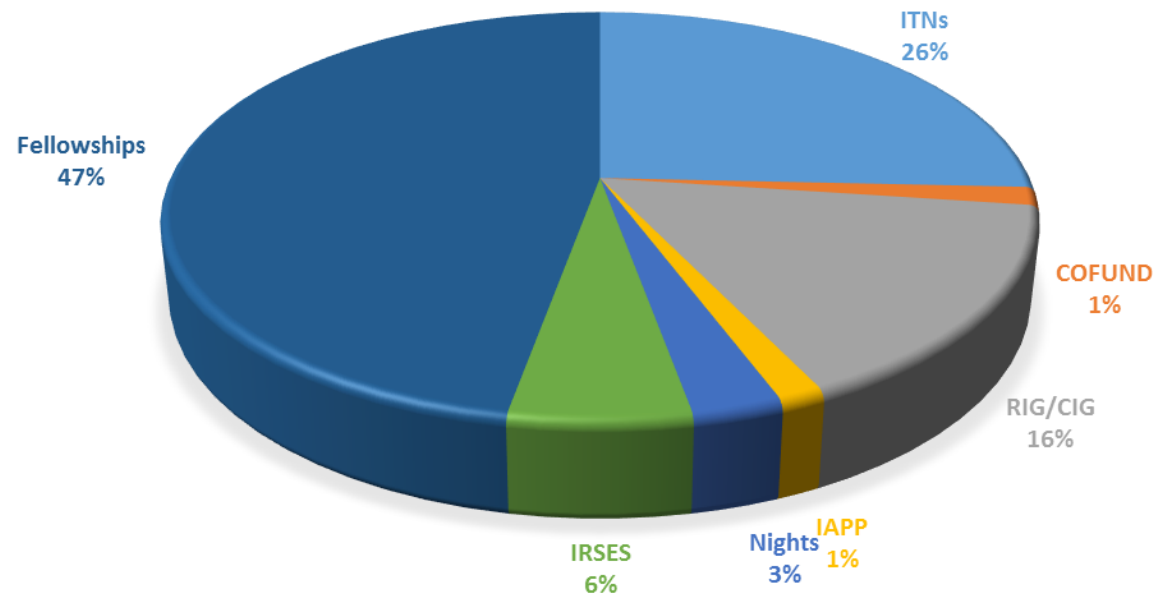


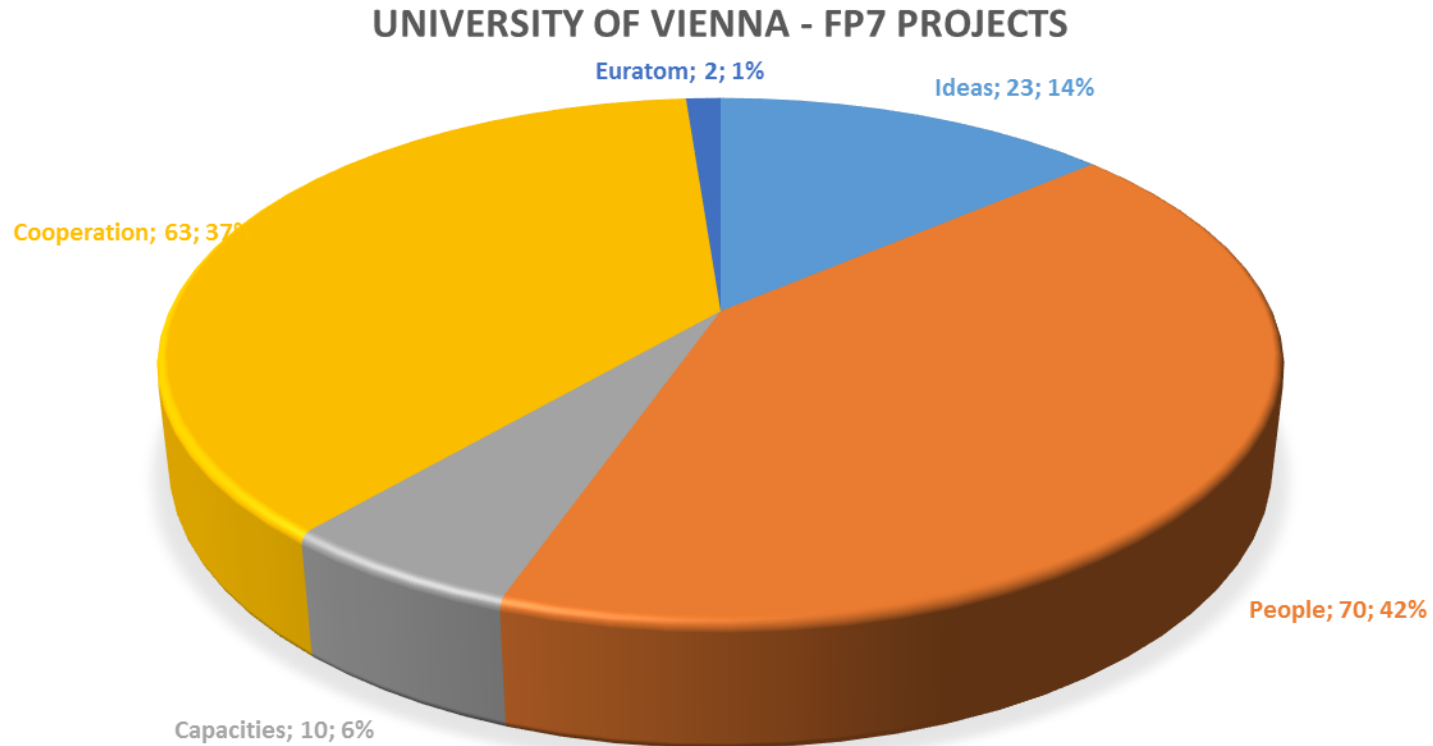

- Gap between Marie Curie Allowance and Salary
 - PhDs and Post Docs
 - No Type B contracts in Austria
 - Must pay the ‚Collective Bargaining Agreement‘ salary and indexation
 - Austrian correction factor not increased since 2010 Work Programme
- Consortium Agreements and ITNs
 - overheads
 - working with Industry
