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Outgoing student mobility: few examples







- Bachelor's degree in Industrial Design: possibility to do a practical internships abroad.
- Master in Architecture: seminar in Japan (with a professor from UdeM. It including architecturals and industrials visits).
- École d'architecture de paysage: many possibilities to spend a study period abroad (France, Germany, Belgium, Spain, Thailand, Australia, China, Chili and Brasil).



- Master in Political Science: seminar (2012-2013) in collaboration with ULB: « The North American and European parliamentaries systems ».
- Since 2002, our Faculty of Law are organizing a summer program in Beijing, in China, with the China University of Political Science and Law (CUPL). During 4 weeks, students from UdeM and from others universities are taking classes on chineese law, and are doing professisonnals and culturals visits.
- Since 2006, our Faculty of Law are holding a Summer School in Montreal for students and chineese jurists.
- Objective: to increase by 50 % the number of outgoing students (actually = 4,5 %)
- Action: to diversify the internationals study journey types



International specialization



One of the main objectives in recent updating of undergraduate studies at UdeM

Outline

- Obligation to study abroad for at least one semester
- Mastering specific, disciplinary contents with an international orientation: at least 12 credits

Contents

A combination of the following:

- UdeM courses having an international scope
- Language or culture courses
- Practical or professional internships abroad
- Integration activities at UdeM : seminars, lectures, tutorials

Requirements

- The specialization is a path to excellence reserved for top students
- Access is determined by the faculties and departments;
- An « *International specialization* » mention appears on the diploma if all courses and internships are successfully completed

- Bachelor's degree in Sociology






International Recruitment
