Site Visits

- Budapest → Nicosia → Brussels → Tallinn → Bratislava → Budapest
- Participants: max. 30
- Aims: ground for brainstorming, exchanging good practices and promoting the "ExchangeAbility" of disabled students.
- Duration: 1 day and a half
- Structure:
 - Get to know each other activity
 - Introduction about university's accessible facilities and inclusive policy, done by university officers on special needs
 - Awareness Raising Workshop
 - Interviews and Testimonies of local students with different types of disabilities;
 - Round table discussions
 - Site visit to university facilities
 - Wrap-up and conclusions.
- Production of audiovisual material, evaluations and reports
- Steering Committee meeting (management & administrative issues)
- Organization: Hosting university officials, ESN section and ExchangeAbility Ambassadors'


