- Integrating sustainability aspects of research, teaching, and campus (buildings that teach)
- Climate change adaptation, sustainable food on and off campus
- Energy efficiency (Europe), student involvement (US), massive construction (Asia)

"The ISCN is a global forum for leading universities to exchange ideas and best practices for integrating sustainability into campus operations, research and teaching."

Our Approach

ISCN-GULF Sustainable Campus Charter

based on 3 principles for campus sustainability (buildings, planning, integration); signed by over 50 university Presidents from across 6 continents

Conferences

attended by 400 individuals over the last years, representing more than 200 organizations

Campus Sustainability Excellence Awards

issued to 18 universities in 11 countries since 2011

Working Groups

publishing first ISCN book in 2013,

"Regenerative Sustainable Development of Universities and Cities."



ISCN-GULF Sustainable Campus Charter

Supports universities in target setting and in reporting



Charter Reporting

- Provides a framework for priority-setting and goals development
- Motivates follow-through and accountability
- Inspires each other and sharing ideas
- Provides a basis for benchmarking
- Allows for cross-references with other reporting frameworks (e.g. GRI)
