



Public Funding

Donations: currently 17 million Euro

Raiffeisen, Voestalpine: 2 million each


Mondi, OMV: 1 million each


GO@IST in figures (I)

€ 40 mio. in total






Organizational Chart

LEAR:

Head of Grant Office (B. Abraham)

FSIGN (for all projects):

Head of Finance (M. Raith)

LSIGN (for all projects):

President (T. Henzinger)

President is legally the only external representative at IST

IST law



Electronic signature requirements

Declaration of honour/Grant Agreement

- GO prints it, then it is signed manually by the President (LSIGN) on paper
- Documentation held in GO
- online via the President's account by GO

Form C:

FP7: Signature on the DRAFT Form C needed if CFS has to be done

Reports:

No signed paper kept additionally



Participant Portal users at IST (I)

Pre-award:

- the PI in ERC projects
- the professor being partner
- MSCA: professor and fellow
- Grant Office (additional to the abovementioned)

Post-award (negotiations):

- Grant Office (Coordinator/Participant Contact)
- Person directly involved (professor/fellow)



Participant Portal users at IST (II)

Post-award (reporting):

- Grant Office no need to add the LEAR
- Fellow (MSCA)
- PI (ERC) only in rare cases

GO provides templates for reporting and fills in the information from professor etc. into PP

HBP: also EMDESK is filled by GO



Consortium management


Confirming eligibility & financial viability of the partner institutions and their eligibility - Coordinators at risk? :

- No coordinating role so far (except for COFUND)
- Declarations from partners
- Good consortium agreements



MSCA – Fellows and mobility rules

IF:

- Fellows are in personal contact with GO, in person when already on campus
- Check by talking to them and to the professor responsible
- Check by email otherwise
- No documents needed by GO but Academic Affairs (close contact in the recruiting process)

COFUND:

Documents are required when applying in the system



MSCA - ITN

ITN:

- ITN does not fit 100% with the concept of our PhD program, ITN position has to be advertised already parallel to the with Grad School call
- Rotations: sometimes difficult to time, depends on the beginning of project
- Fellow has to start to work on project after affiliation, this has
 to be within the 1st year to cover the mobility rule
- Fellows' background is checked by the PI
