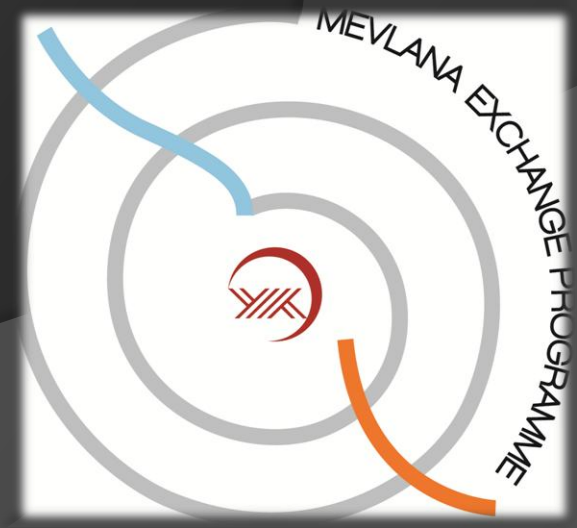

**Even if you deny your oaths a hundred times come!**

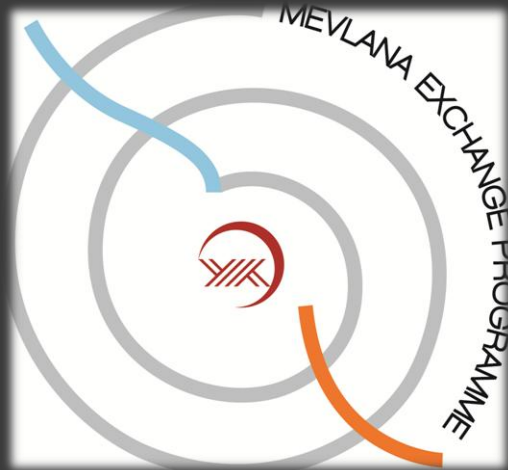

# What is Mevlana Exchange Programme?

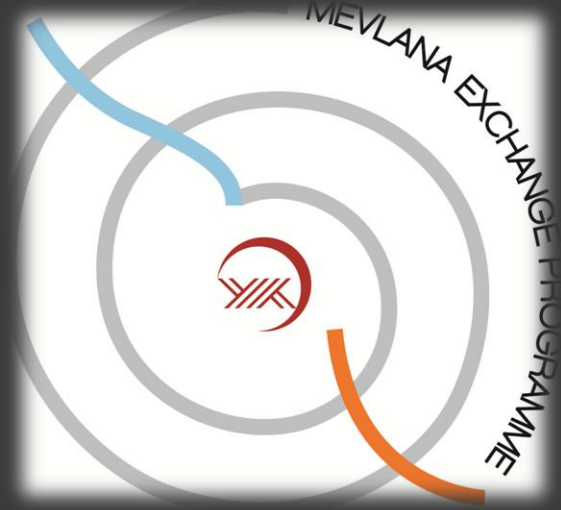
A new exchange programme between higher education institutions in Turkey and other -nonEU- countries

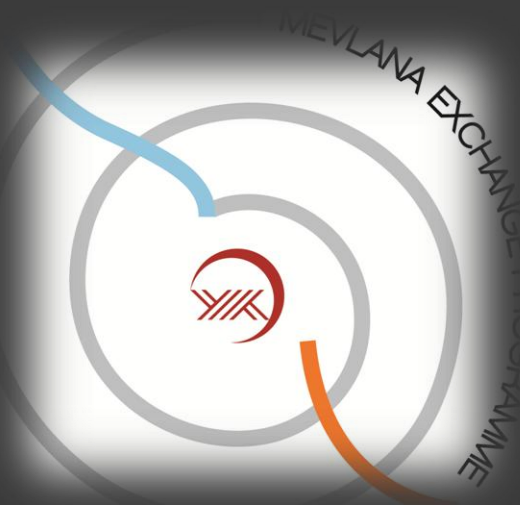

# Who can benefit from Mevlana Exchange Programme?

Students (undergraduate, graduates) registered in formal academic staff who work ...on condition that the higher education programmes at higher education institutions or signed a bilateral Mevlana Exchange Protocol education institutions in Turkey and in other countries



# What is required for students?

- Turkish language
- $\text{GPA} \geq 2.5$  (4.0), for undergraduate
- $\text{GPA} \geq 3.0$  (4.0), for graduate
- Exception: First year undergrads, prep class students

- A scholarship is be paid based on life standarts in host country

# Financial Support - Students -

GNP > 10,000 \$	$280 \times 3 = 840$ TL
GNP 5,000 -10,000 \$	$280 \times 2 = 560$ TL
GNP < 5,000 \$	$280 \times 1,5 = 420$ TL
Incoming students	$280 \times 2 = 560$ TL
