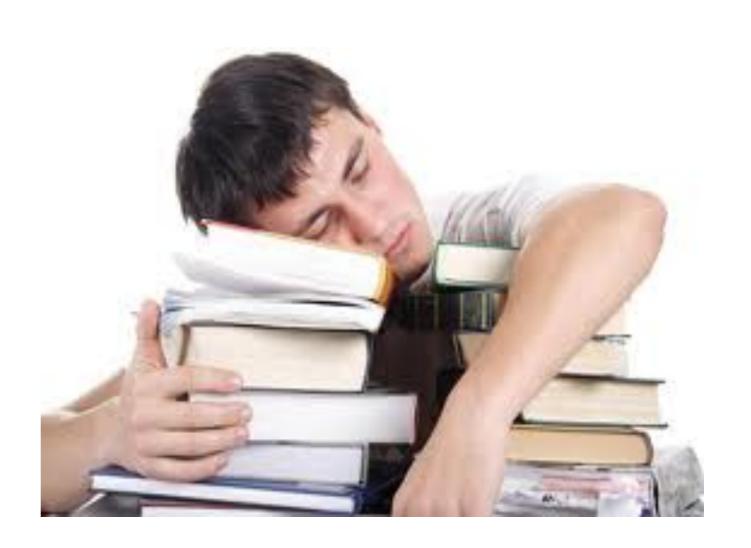

- 6. Competence based learning

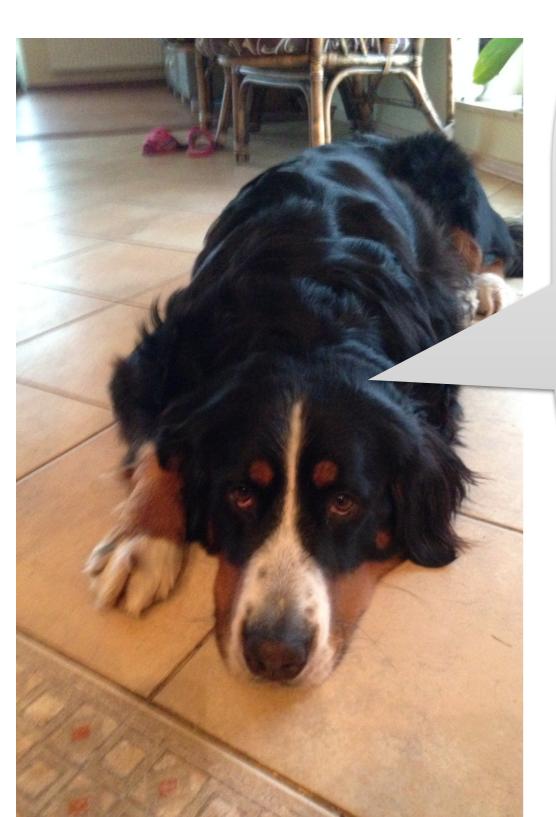
