




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Different types of degrees







Action Line 1: Activities


- Assessment of differentiated joint programmes:
 - · EM Master Journalism and Media within Globalisation
 - Bachelor European Teacher Education for Primary Schools
 - · European Master in Comparative Local Development
 - · European Master in International Humanitarian Action
 - · Research Master Geosciences of Basins and Lithosphere -
- Assessments test different methodologies:
 - Existing / new / joint standards
 - · Experts from some of the relevant / all relevant countries
 - · One / two site visits
 - · Decisions based on ordinary / new / joint criteria



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



Action Line 2: Results


- Observations:
 - These qualifications /degrees are not treated differently
 - Legal aspects are a serious obstacle towards recognition.
 - Joint programmes and joint qualifications need to be better incorporated into the national higher education systems
 - ENIC-NARIS are aware of the fact that some institutions use joint programmes to escape national legislation
 - The degree and the diploma supplement do not provide the necessary information about the joint programme
 - All ENIC-NARICs agree that a joint programme needs to be quality assured and/or accredited



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A way forward

- HEIs offering joint programmes should:
 - Award qualifications/degrees in such a way that recognition is facilitated
 - · Be able to now what is expected of them
- A need for guidelines perhaps?
 - Conformity to national legislation re. HEI, JPs and (J)Ds
 - . Transparency and clarity from but also for
 - · national authorities, QAAs and HEIs
 - Essential and required information provided by:
 - · the degree
 - · the Diploma Supplement
