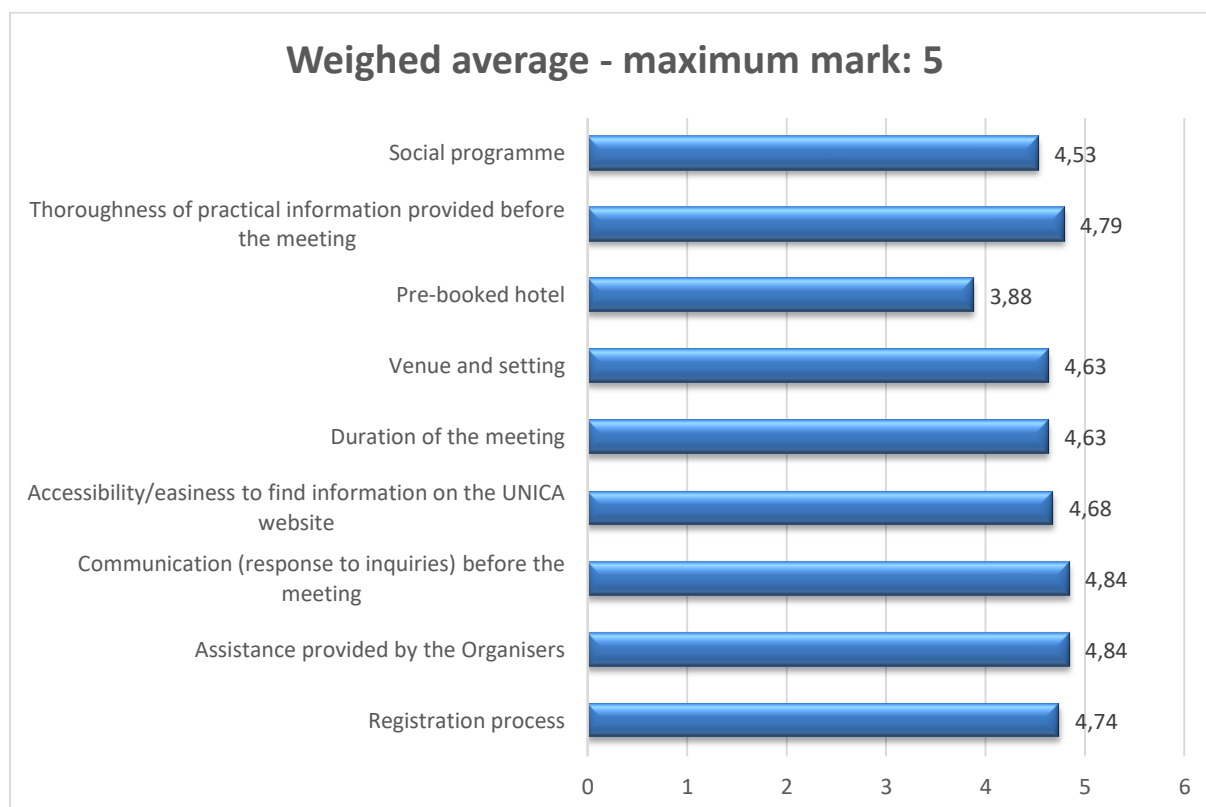

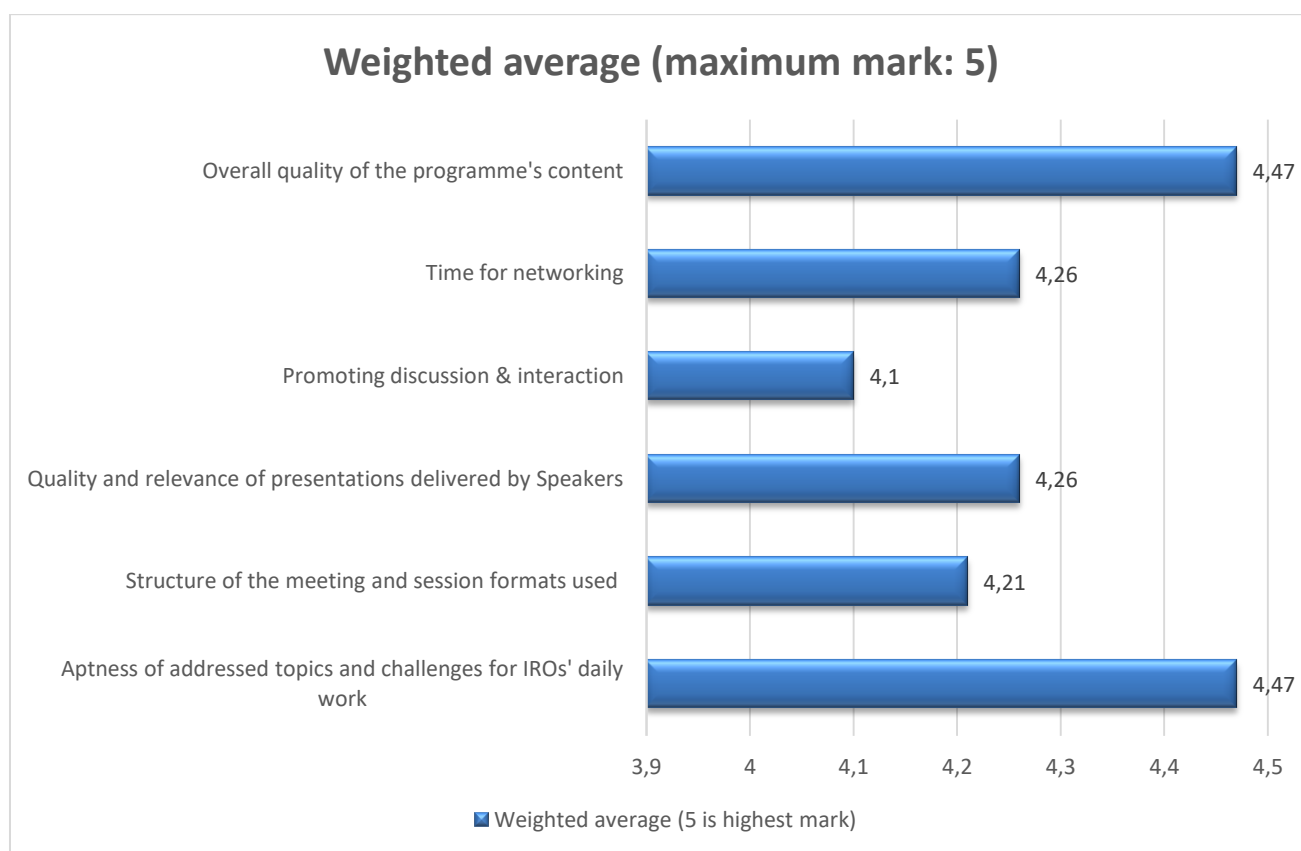

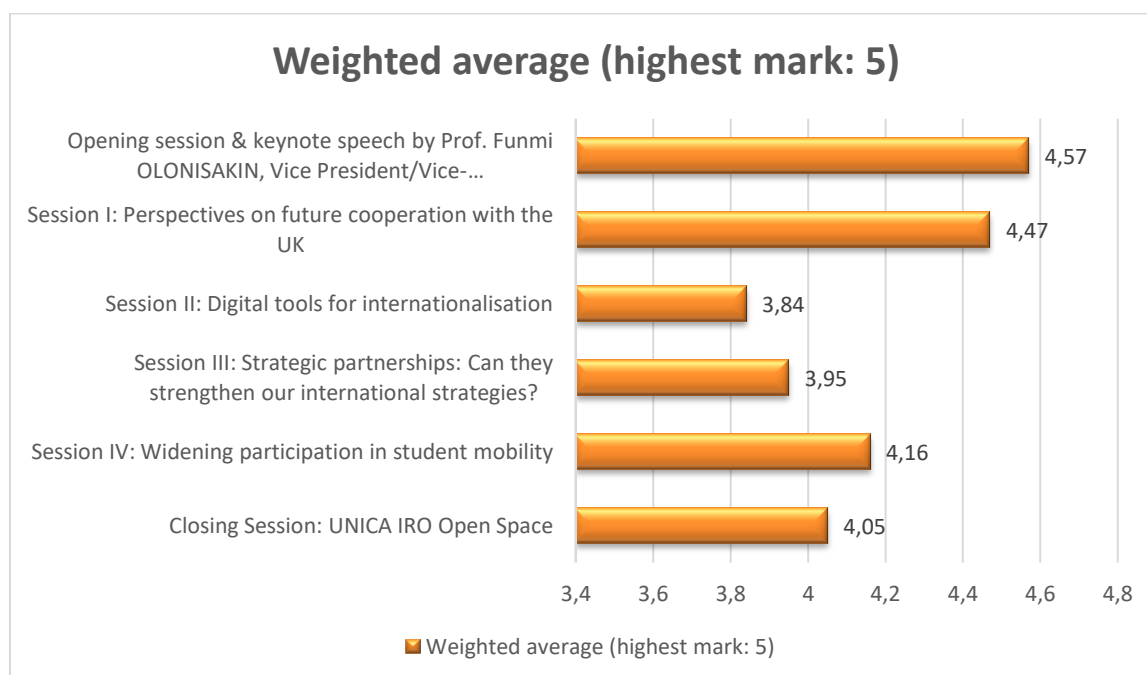

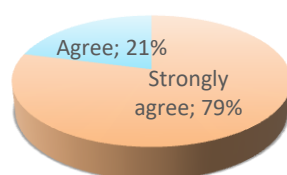


### Comment (1, original wording):

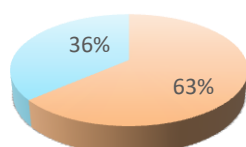
## III. Opportunities provided and level of satisfaction

It allowed me to gain new useful information and learn about interesting practices in other institutions



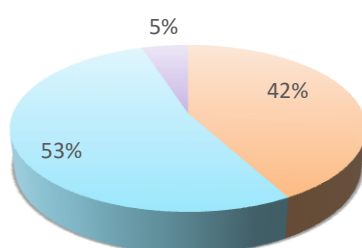
Strongly agree Agree

It gave good opportunities for interaction and exchange of experience with other IROs

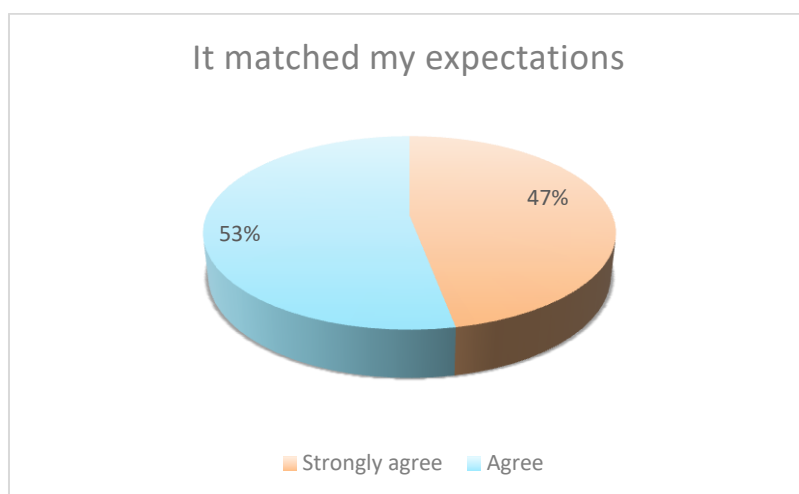

The content was relevant to the challenges I face in my daily work

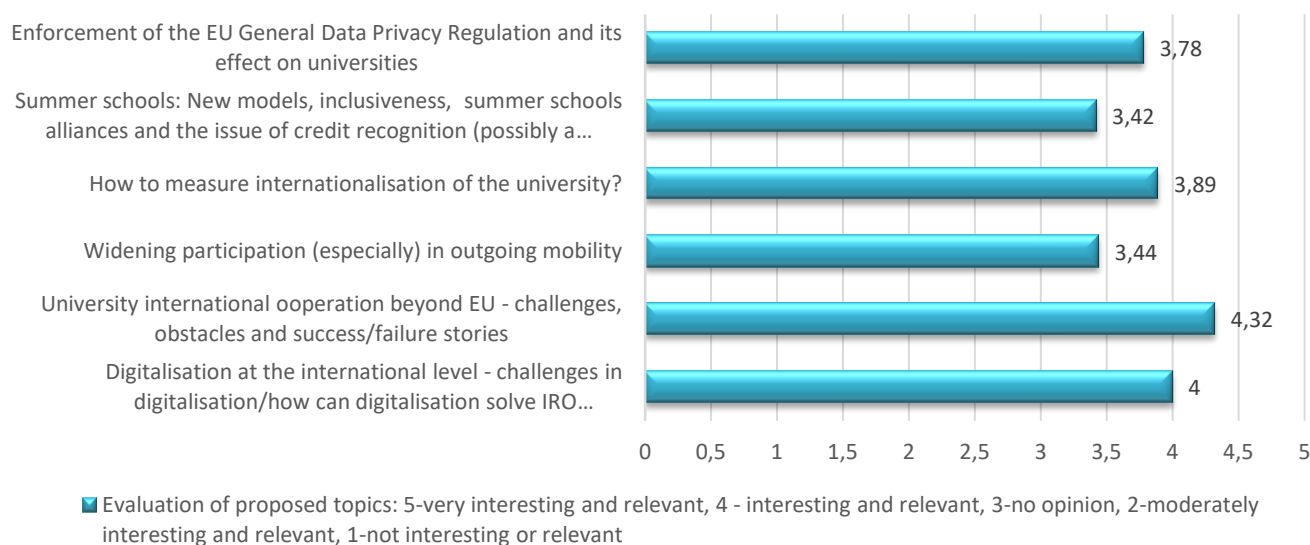
