universities (Novi Sad, Niš...)








Legal framework

Bologna Declaration – signed in 2003 (Berlin)

- Law on Higher Education
 - enacted in 2005 Bologna principles
 - Three cycle system
 - Mobility
 - Quality control
- 2017 Law on Higher Education

HE Bodies in Serbia

- Ministry of Education, Science and Technological Development
- National Council for Higher Education (NCHE)
- Commission for Accreditation and Quality Assurance (CAQA) (Member of ENQA from 2013, and EQAR from 2014) – Now National Accreditation Body – certificate for accreditation
 - MESTD work permit
- Conference of Universities of Serbia (CONUS)
- Conference of Academies of Applied Studies (CAAS)
- Student Conference of Universities
- Student Conference of Academies of Applied Studies

New Law on Higher Education (2017):

- Strengthening third mission of universities
- Introduction of short-cycle and part-time studies
- Strengthening the cooperation with industry -Council of Employers
- New category of teaching staff top business experts
- Higher governmental control and less institutional autonomy

Challenges

- National
 - University authonomy
 - Financing of public universities

- International
 - Participation in the EU research programmes
 - Serbia in the European Education Area

National challenges

- CONUS representatives in the National Council for HE and National Accreditation Body
 - Decrease in the NCHE (from 12 to 6)
 - CAQA members are no longer nominated by the CONUS
- National council elected by the Government instead of the Parliament
- Increased number of the government representatives in the Council of Public HEI
- Ban on recruitment of public employees in Serbia affecting university administrative staff


National challenges




FIGURE 16: Number of participations to Horizon 2020 per Member State, 2014-2016, and share of total Horizon 2020 participations
