









Types of networks: Size

= Weak tie = Strong tie




Strengths & Weaknesses

	Strength	Weakness
Large scale networks	 Knowledge search is eased as the pool of knowledge to search from is more diverse Exploration activities are eased 	 Easier for partners to violate an obligation to provide resources Governance challenges Hard to get rid of non-performers
Small scale networks	 Easier to build trust Knowledge transfer between partners is eased Exploitation activities are eased 	 Partner knowledge may be redundant Difficult to ensure a diverse pool of knowledge

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
The complexity of the Black Sea Region: What can do the Universities?
