- ✓ Contribute to global HE news, debates and associations

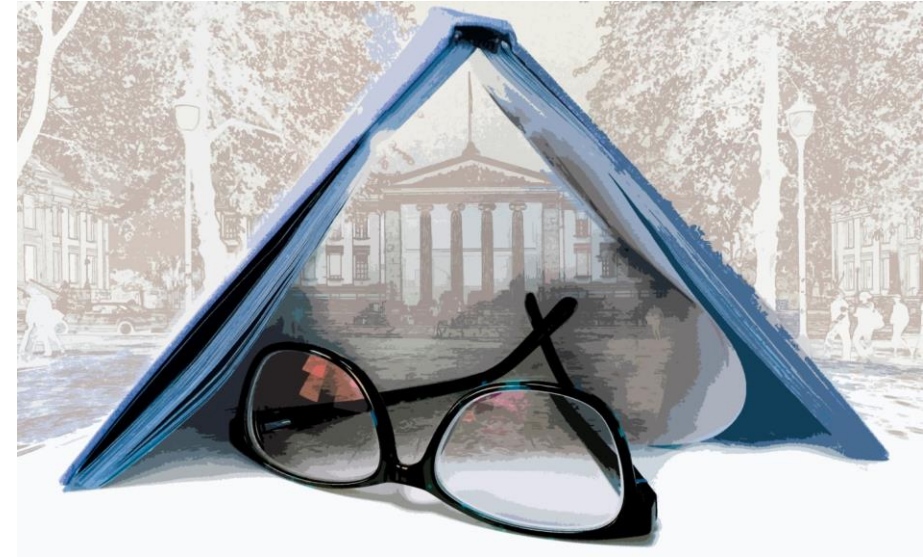

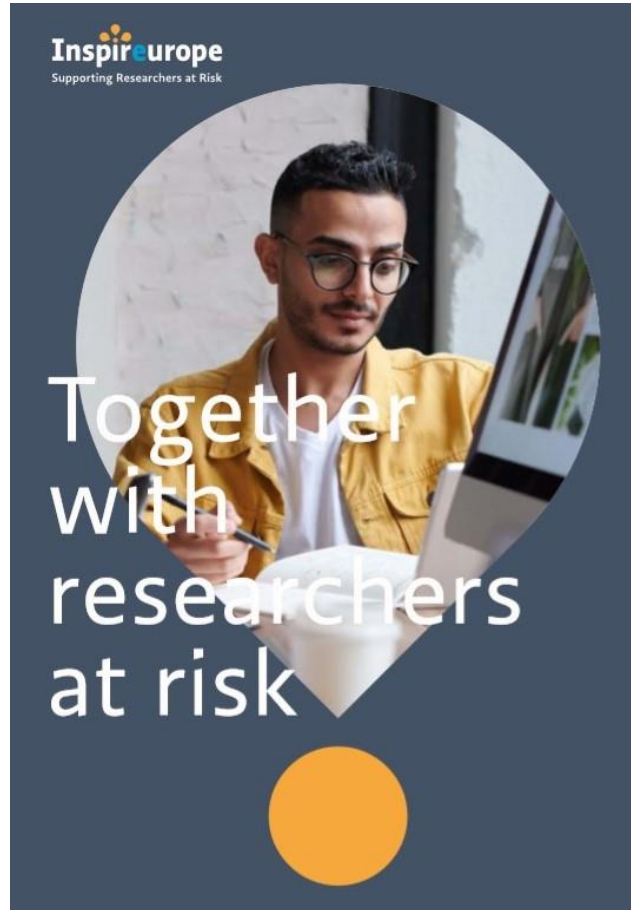
