


Research at the Higher School of Economics

- 3 bln roubles is an average amount allocated to research
- 800+ research fellows
- 600+ research projects per year
- ~1000 research projects in sociology
- 140 basic research projects per year
- 350 applied research projects per year

- 200+ entities commissioning applied projects per year
- 15 monitoring studies on different aspects of Russian social and economic development
- 290 mln roubles is the value of intellectual property owned by HSE
- ~300 international partners from more than 50 countries
- ~25 government research projects per year

How we build bridge between academics and users through online-courses?


- The team of the course communicates with users on forums of the platform

As HSE has more than 40 buildings around Moscow, the university is highly integrated in the city.








University Open to the City

Activities included in the project:

- Open lectures:
 - o In the Gorky park − 13 lectures in 10 areas, the audience around 2600 people
 - At VDNH (The Exhibition of Achievements of National Economy) 24 lectures, 3000 people
 - Thursday's lectures in museums: GULAG museum, Moscow museum, Darvin museum, etc. – 16 lectures in 10 areas, 1350 people
 - Cycle of lectures of young scientists in culture center ZIL 13 lectures, 2600 people
 - Joint project with Jewish museum and tolerance center "Campus"
 - HSE Talks In February 2017 we have launched a new project of lectures in English
- City projects Night of Arts, different science festivals and other activities.
- Day of HSE around 50 000 people each year, including 6300 people who come to open lectoriums
- Students for the city Green HSE, charity festival "Heroes among us".


Daily audience 4000 people on weekdays

Average number of sessions


