Getting to Rome

From Rome Fiumicino Airport

By train (Leonardo Express) → to Termini Station:

Ticket: € 14.00 Fiumicino -> Termini Station Every 30 minutes: from 6:37 to 23:37 Termini Station -> Fiumicino Every 30 minutes: from 5:52 to 22:52 N.B.: Leonardo Express train makes no stops on the way. Route time: 35 minutes

By train (Regional Train) \rightarrow to Tiburtina Station:

Tickets: € 8.00 Fiumicino > Tiburtina Station > Fiumicino (every 15 minutes from Monday to Saturday, every 30 minutes on Sundays) Route time: 47 minutes

By Shuttle Bus:

The bus line Terravision Shuttle Bus connects Fuimicino Airport with Termini train station.

Tickets: €9 one way or €15 return (cheaper tickets available on the web), total duration: 60 minutes. Other companies also operate this route.

By taxi:

There are fixed taxi fares from downtown to the airport. The fare for the journey between the city centre to Fiumicino and vice-versa is around \in 48. Luggage fee is around \in 1 per bag. Be aware that Fiumicino is outside of the city, therefore the starting fare from the airport is higher (2nd price range), however the driver should switch back to 1st price range as soon as you reach the ring road (G.R.A) signalling the entrance to the city. You can also opt for a shared taxi (door-to-door): <u>www.airportshuttle.it</u> and book it online at a single fare of \in 25 (from Fiumicino airport to the hotel).


By bus (non-stop transfer to Termini station):

Rome Ciampino airport can be reached via different bus routes. Daily direct connections between the airport and FS Roma Termini station are guaranteed by the bus services operated by ATRAL, COTRAL, SIT and TERRAVISION. The buses are parked in dedicated bus stops by the exit for International Departures. Tickets can be bought directly from the bus driver.

By train:

The nearest railway station is Ciampino Città station, connected to/from the airport by the following buses: COTRAL/SCHIAFFINI. Both buses depart every 30 minutes and **tickets** can be bought in the bus and on the ground and they cost € 1,20. The journey takes about 5 minutes. From Ciampino Città station, you can take a train to Termini station. Departures are frequent (every 15 minutes) and it takes about 20 minutes.









By metro:

The nearest metro station is ANAGNINA, connected to/from the airport by buses COTRAL/SCHIAFFINI which depart every 30 minutes. Once at Anagnina, take the line A (red line), which makes several stops in the city centre, including Termini station.

By taxi:

There are fixed fares from downtown to airports. The fare for the journey between the city centre to Ciampino and vice-versa is around €30. Luggage fee is about €1 per bag.


Public transport

The cost of a single public transport ticket is €1.50 (100 min – multiple bus rides/single subway ride). Tickets can be purchased at most newsagents and coffee shops and at vending machines at bus stops and metro stations around the city.

Most buses run from 5:30am to 12:00am (night buses are available after midnight). Underground trains run from 5:30pm to 11:30pm Sunday to Thursday and from 5:30am to 1:30am on Fridays and Saturdays. For further information see: http://www.atac.roma.it

Taxis


Taxis in Rome are white, have an identification name and number on the front door and are equipped with a taximeter. They can be easily found in every part of the city at special taxi ranks, or you can call one of the numerous Radio Taxi companies like 06 3570, 06 6645, 06 8822, 06 4157, 06 4994 or 06 5551.

CU001: Meeting venue (May 22) – Rectorate Bulding – Senate Hall






