TRAVELLING TO NICOSIA

There are two airports in Cyprus. One is located in Larnaca and the other one in Paphos. There are good flight connections between Larnaca/Paphos and other European countries.

HOW TO GET TO NICOSIA CENTRE, WHERE THE HOTELS AND THE UNIVERSITY OF CYPRUS ARE LOCATED

Please note that the Hilton Park Hotel can organise a pick-up/drop-off service to/from Larnaca International Airport at the current taxi fare (€ 50,00). If you would like to book this service please contact Ms Elena Demosthenous at elena.Demosthenous@hilton.com providing your arrival and departure details.

From Larnaca Airport

A. By taxi

When you arrive at the airport you can follow TAXI signs. Travelling to Nicosia by taxi should cost you between 50 and 60 Euro, depending on the time of your arrival. You can use this option in case the bus timetable (see below) is not convenient depending on your arrival time, i.e. between 1.00 a.m. to 5.00 a.m.

B. By bus

When you arrive at the airport, you can follow signs for the KAPNOS AIRPORT SHUTTLE. Travelling to Nicosia by bus will cost you 8 Euros. You can book your transportation on line, a few days prior to your arrival, at the following webpage: http://www.kapnosairportshuttle.com/

The distance from the Nicosia bus stop to the Hilton Park Hotel (if you choose this hotel) is about 8km so you will need to take a taxi. There are usually taxis waiting at the Nicosia bus station.

From Paphos Airport

To get to the University of Cyprus or Hilton Park Hotel, the easiest way to reach Nicosia is by taxi which will cost €100 approximately.

Passport and Visa

A valid passport (or ID card if you are a citizen from an EU member state) is required in order to enter the Republic of Cyprus. Please make sure that your passport is valid until at least 3 months after your departure date from Cyprus. Citizens of the European Union countries do not need a visa to enter Cyprus.

List of countries, whose citizens do NOT need a visa for a stay up to 90 days, provided they are bona fide visitors.
