## **Present conversion practices**

- The credits are transferred and recognised, but no formal grade conversion takes places, hence no local marks are given.
- Each programme coordinator draws up a table with equivalences between the home marks and that of the partner institution/country. They may be done at the central level or the faculty/department.
- Grades are recognised comparing qualitative descriptors.
- The ECTS Grading table introduced in the Users' Guide 2009

## **Aggregation level**

- May differ from country to country
- The course unit would be ideal but not feasible
- Alternatives: degree programmes, groups of degrees, faculty, entire university
- The ECTS Users' Guide mentions: 'a single programme or group of homogeneous programmes from which a consistent grading could be derived' (grading culture)
- Egracons proposes the use of the ISCED study area codes (Eurostat/OECD/UNESCO): 3 or 4 digits
