

UNICA STUDENT CONFERENCE 2017

PROCEDURE OF AWARDING STUDENT ACTION PLANS

On the last day of the Student Conference (Saturday, 7 October), **each Student Forum will present an action plan** competing for **two categories of prizes**:

1. the **Students' Vote Prize** (vote by paper ballots);
2. the **Jury Prize**.

Composition of the Jury

The Jury will be composed of the UNICA President, the UNICA Steering Committee members attending the Student Conference on Saturday, 7 October, and the UNICA Secretary General.

The **students of the two winning action plans will receive symbolic prizes** at the Conference, and **will be asked to submit full project proposals with requests for small UNICA co-funding by 20 December 2017** (detailed instructions will be sent in due time).

In addition to the two winning Student Fora, **the UNICA Steering Committee might invite other Student Fora who presented very interesting action plans**, to submit their project.

Selection criteria for the Jury Prize at the Conference

1. Originality
2. Applicability and sustainability
3. Relevance and impact

Selection criteria for the co-funding of one project proposal

1. Originality
2. Applicability and sustainability
3. Relevance and impact
4. Well-defined governance & leadership
5. Co-funding for at least 50% of the budget by a UNICA Member university or another Higher Education stakeholder.
