Distance learning	Reduce GHG emissions due to commuting (students)	From September : Blended approach : e-learning (2/3) and classroom sessions by rotation of small groups of students (1/3) → Switch to 100% e-learning if necessary Support measures : <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Increase HR to support teaching staff • Support less-advantaged students (IT material, connection costs, access to study rooms, etc.) → cf. results of internal survey
