



## **Massification of higher education**


Universities per million population

## Participation in higher education


World gross enrollment ratio, tertiary education, %

# Growth of higher education across the globe






#### Massification leads to institutional diversity

- Mission differentiation
- 'Blurring boundaries' of higher education institutions (e.g. 'end of binary systems', research universities)
- Internal diversity ('subject mix')

Structure of education by type of HEI in Russia





>1300 courses >70 universities


