





- 8 faculties



- Summer schools: only a few online




- Recruitment agents



#### **Application deadlines**


- ▶ 1 April for Non-EEA students (student visa)
- ▶ 1 September for EEA students (+Non-EEA with valid residence permit)

#### **Language requirements**

- ► Language test: TOEFL iBT Special Home Edition + IELTS Indicator
- Interview to assess English proficiency

#### **Online enrolment**

Conditional letter of acceptance: confirmation diploma

What is the impact of the (ongoing) pandemic on our student population? **Only time will tell** 










