

# Academic heritage University of Belgrade



- The University of Belgrade's heritage dates back to 1835 when the first mineralogical collection was given to the Serbian Grand Duke Milosh by the German Barron Von Herder.
- The University of Belgrade also influenced the formation of the National Museum of Serbia (1844) by appointing its professors as the first Keepers, whom contributed greatly by establishing the Museum and its collections.



- In the recent years activities concerning our academic heritage have increased significantly and may be symbolized as the ongoing  $\pi 3$  initiative serving 3 basic goals:
- *Prevention*- risk management in order to prevent devastation of items and collections;
- *Preservation*-encouraging and implementing national museum standards and procedures;
- *Promotion*-introducing collections to scholars as research potential with scientific capacity and presenting its cultural values to general public.

- The academic heritage of the University of Belgrade today represents a unique entity testifying of development and significance of academic life in Serbia.
- This entity is divided in 3 sectors:
  - architectural and natural heritage,
  - libraries and
  - museum/collections

# Architectural and natural heritage

- 14 member faculties are housed in the buildings that are under protection of the Ministry of culture of the Republic of Serbia.
- The magnificent structure of the Rectorate, Kapetan Mišino zdanje, is recognised by the same body as the national monument of culture.
- 4 member faculties are proud owners of landscapes that are categorized as natural heritage: Agronomy, Geology and Mining, Biology and Forestry.





# Libraries

- University library “Svetozar Marković” is in charge of all the libraries belonging to faculties, departments and institutes of the University of Belgrade
- The edifice is the very first building in Serbia that was designed and erected in 1926 to serve as the library. It was declared as the monument of culture in 1977.
