THREE FOCAL POINTS FOR UNICA IN THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2018/2019

The announcement of the new "European university networks" initiative provided a fresh impetus and prompted Higher Education networks and associations to pause and reflect on their unique value propositions. In the new academic year, we want to build on what makes UNICA special, while staying open to new opportunities and proposals from our Members.

The added value of metropolitan, urban universities



Whether located right in the city centre among the historic landmarks or secluded on the city's outskirts, being a **metropolitan**, **urban university** is definitely a distinctive characteristic of UNICA Members, and it carries benefits and challenges alike. Through the "University, Culture and the City" initiative and UNICA's involvement in the Diplomatic, Economic, Ac-

ademic and Cultural (DEAC) Missions organised in collaboration with CIDIC (International Consular and Diplomatic Circle), we want to highlight the place that UNICA Member Universities hold in the Cities' social, cultural, economic life, and the special role they play in the development of the (capital) city and the country as a whole. At the same time, we have also set out the ambition to address the "urban" component and place more focus on interdisciplinary research during activities of other UNICA Working Groups and Seminars for Rectors & Vice-Rectors. To this end, the February UNICA Seminar for Vice-Rectors & Vice-Presidents for Research: Urban research universities addressing global challenges, to be hosted by Vrije Universiteit Brussel, will be dedicated to the application of university research for urban and regional policy making and for implementing transformative urban changes.

2 UNICA as a forum for academic leadership

Over the last three academic years, we have worked towards **strengthening the links with academic leadership** of UNICA Member Universities and helping academic leaders within the Network to **develop trust-based relationships.** In the new academic year, **eight Rectors meetings** will take place, including three dedicated



Rectors Seminars and the first edition of a MAS-TER CLASS on Internationalisation for Vice-Rectors & Vice-Presidents for International Affairs. organised jointly with International Association of Universities (IAU). The meetings will serve as a forum for academic leaders from UNICA Member Universities to exchange experiences on issues related to policy development, strate-

gic planning and change management at universities. At the same time, many of the meetings will highlight important milestones in the history of the Hosting **Universities:** We take pride in the fact that UNICA Rectors Seminars taking place in the academic year 2018/2019 will mark the 350th founding anniversary of the University of Zagreb and the centennial jubilees of Comenius University in Bratislava and the University of Latvia.

Continuous competency development & peer learning for university staff



With the expansion of university missions, growth of university services and ongoing changes in the European Higher Education landscape, university academic and non-academic staff are expected to continuously upgrade their competencies. At UNICA, we strongly believe that the experience in giving advice, highlighted by numerous consultancies

now offering training for university staff, often comes second to the actual sharing of experience among those working in the field. For this reason, UNICA continues to organise meetings that serve as a platform for new information and provide a friendly environment for peer learning, peer counselling and networking. We also want to facilitate and support the development of project proposals that can respond directly to the challenges faced by university staff in their dayto-day work. In this context, we are especially looking forward to starting the **Teaching with Erasmus+ project.** which will seek to facilitate access to teaching mobility opportunities (especially for junior teaching staff) and improve quality assurance of teaching mobility. The online platform to be developed in the proiect's framework will be an extension of the existing IMOTION Staffmobility.eu website and will enable the development of new website functionalities for users with both academic and non-academic positions.

ACADEMIC REFUGE: Strategic Partnership to Promote Core Academic Values and Welcome Refugees and Threatened Academics to European Campuses

Aim: In the context of the global migration crisis and the conflicting pressures & priorities of HE internationalisation, the ACADEMIC REFUGE project aims to improve the capacity of European universities to support refugee students and threatened academics on European campuses. It also promotes respect for and protection of core Higher Education values.

The key project activities are:

- development of a staff training curriculum on welcoming refugee students and threatened academics to European campuses and organisation of a pilot staff training,
- launch of a MOOC on Academic Freedom and other core Higher Education values.
- creation of an online publication on putting HE values into practice.

UNICA's role: Editor of the e-Handbook on putting core academic values into practice, active contribution to all deliverables of the project, design of the staff training week curriculum on welcoming refugee students and academics on European campuses



Teaching with Erasmus+

Aim: Erasmus Impact Study 2014 identified Staff mobility (including the one of teachers) as key priority to be included in internationalisation strategies of HEIs. In several previous projects and studies on the topic, have been identified as obstacles that prevent teaching staff (and institutions) from using staff mobility schemes.

The project aims to tackle these issues by:

- developing a set of criteria to measure the quality of teaching mobility and providing a framework of assessment of teaching mobility activities,
- creating an online database of innovative teaching methodologies and tools to support teaching mobility,
- launching an online platform (Erasmus+ Teaching Mobility Platform, ETMP) where HEIs can offer and find teaching opportunities; the platform will be an extension of Staffmobility.eu platform created in the framework of IMOTION project and currently maintained by UNICA,
- devising policy recommendations on teaching mobility, to be incorporated in the next EU higher education programme post 2020.

UNICA's role: Contribution to the development of the ETMP platform and the re-design of Staffmobility.eu, co-leading dissemination activities together with European University Foundation (EUF), impact analysis of the project and finalising the project's policy recommendations.

Aim: Although significant steps have been made toward the modernisation and alignment of Uzbek doctoral education with the state-of-the-art developments in the European Higher Education Area, there are still many challenges to be tackled. Building on the outcomes of the former UZDOC project, conducted with the support of the EU Tempus programme, UZDOC 2.0. aims at furthering the quality of doctoral education at Uzbek partner HE Institutions and strengthening the implementation of doctoral education reforms in Uzbekistan.

Specific project objectives:

- To improve the capacity of Uzbekistan HEIs for supporting doctoral education, in line with the latest EHEA developments in the area of doctoral education
- To raise the capacity of Uzbekistan HEIs in implementing national standards for quality assurance in doctoral education
- To increase the capacity of academic and non-academic human resources in Uzbekistan HEIs to contribute toward the implementation of the reforms of doctoral education
- To improve the collaboration between the academic and business sector and industry in Uzbekistan, reducing the skills gap between doctorate holders and the business sector.

SAVES2: Students Achieving Valuable Energy Savings 2

Under Horizon 2020 Programme

Project Period: 01/05/2017-31/10/2020

Partners: UNICA, National and Kapodistrian University of Athens, University of Cyprus, University of Bucharest, Sofia University "St. Kliment Ohridski" (all four UNICA members), Technical University of Crete, Vilnius Gediminas Technical University, Ecovisum LTD, Union of Students in Ireland, Monfort University

Aim: SAVES2 continues the efforts of the widely acknowledged SAVES project (funded by the EU Intelligent Energy Europe Programme in 2014-2017), that expanded the Student Switch Off campaign run by the National Union of Students in the UK to four other EU countries (Cyprus, Greece, Lithuania and Sweden) and resulted in over 4 GWhs of saved energy. The SAVES2 project intends to instill sustainable energy behaviours among university students in 7 countries to help them reduce their exposure to fuel poverty and empower them to continue energy-saving actions throughout their daily lives. During 3.5 years of the project. SAVES2 aims to reach 114.000 students living in dormitories with the Students Switch Off campaign (38.000 students per academic year) and save quantifiable amounts of energy in student halls (9GWhs). At the same time, it seeks to engage over 100.000 students planning to move into or living in the private-rented sector to encourage them to make housing choices that minimise their exposure to fuel poverty and improve their understanding of energy performance certification and energy bills.
