Second call for proposals of Mobility Programme SASPRO 2

The second call of the Mobility Programme SASPRO 2 opens on **3. 5. 2021** and its deadline is **31. 8. 2021**. After completion of the second call recruitment process, first researchers should start working in Host Organisations from February 2022. Other commencement dated for successful candidates are May, July and September 2022.

Applications can only be submitted electronically through the system for applications available on the Programme SASPRO 2 website <https://saspro2.sav.sk/>.

Applications are open to researchers of any nationalities who are in possession of PhD degree. Eligible are experienced researchers up to 15 years after obtaining their first PhD or equivalent degree. Eligibility criteria for researchers differ, it is offered two schemes, and both are dedicated to experienced researchers:

Incoming scheme - is dedicated for researchers who have not resided or carried out their main activity (work, studies, etc.) in the Slovak Republic for more than 12 months in the last 3 years prior to the application submission.

Reintegration scheme - is dedicated for Slovak nationals who have carried out their main activity in the Third countries at least 3 years prior to the application submission and who have resided or carried out their main activity in the Slovak Republic for maximum 3 months prior to the application submission.

SASPRO 2 is a Horizon 2020 Marie Skłodowska-Curie COFUND Action based at Slovak Academy of Sciences and its partners Slovak University of Technology and Comenius University in Bratislava.

The aim of the SASPRO 2 Programme is to strengthen the scientific organizations of the Slovak Academy of Sciences, the Slovak University of Technology and Comenius University with researchers from top foreign institutes, improve cooperation between scientific and application sectors, or support multidisciplinary project solutions. In addition, the project aims to deepen the connection between the Slovak Academy of Sciences, the Slovak University of Technology and Comenius University, support
