



UNICA Green and SDGs Working Group

Climate Action Roundtables - Guidance

The programme aims to provide colleagues from UNICA member universities with the **opportunity to meet in small working groups to share experiences of climate action in the higher education sector.**

The roundtables will focus on **four topics**, including carbon foot printing; climate targets; implementing solutions; and developing strategy and governance.

Each roundtable will be limited to a **small number of participants** and will include **three sessions** (each lasting 75 minutes). The first session will be led by a facilitator from the UNICA Green & SDGs Working Group to help colleagues understand the purpose of the sessions and the expected outputs and outcomes.

After the three sessions, each roundtable is asked to provide a **one page summary of key points** – including an overview of the sector; examples of good practice; common challenges and recommendations for colleagues to take action in their own institutions. The summaries can then be shared as a resource with colleagues.

The roundtables will provide colleagues with **opportunities** to share experiences; learn about examples of good practice, share common challenges (and solutions); grow your knowledge of how universities are addressing the climate crisis; and have in depth discussions with members of the UNICA Green and SDGs Working Group.

Registration to participate will take place over the summer (deadline: 23 July 2021), with the roundtables starting from September 2021.
