Target groups

- For whom?
 - International and exchange students
- To whom?
 - Universities
 - Communities, especially civil society





- Internationalisation of higher education and development of intercultural competence in students and staff
 - Language and culture courses for students
 - Language tandem framework
 - Cultural activities (i.e. visits to the cultural and natural heritage spots)
 - Train the staff to facilitate intercultural dialogue and teach in intercultural classrooms
 - Train staff to handle discriminatory behavior
 - Implement Code of Conduct





- Community engagement
 - Opportunities to volunteer and participate in activities facilitated by civil society
 - Especially by activity based student and youth-led associations
 - Opportunity for local and international/exchange students to interact
 - Easy way to access community engagement activities, i.e. Erasmus+ App
 - **Funds** for student-led associations that facilitate community engagement activities





- Community engagement and recognition
 - Framework and a recognition mechanism for community engagement activities conducted as extracurricular activities
 - Diploma supplements, certificates, badges or credits
 - Development paths and assessment/certification, i.e. Erasmus Skills





- Democratic participation
 - Ability to form student representative bodies
 - Opportunity to join and participate in current student bodies and associations, i.e. volunteer, apply for positions

- Trustworthy accommodation providers

- Accessible mental health services
- Mental health providers who work with internationals
