THE CLIMATE ACTION ROUNDTABLES

Meet and share in small working groups with other UNICA members on topics related to climate action in Higher Education!

WHAT

The program intends to provide UNICA member universities with the opportunity to meet and exchange in small working groups on specific topics linked to climate action in HE. The roundtables will act as a "matching platform" gathering together a limited number of participants led by a facilitator to discuss and share experiences and good practices on one of the proposed topics.

TOPICS

- Carbon foot printing
- Setting climate targets for the short to long term
- Implementing solutions
- Developing a global strategy (governance)

HOW

Each roundtable will include 3 sessions (each lasting 75 minutes). The first session will be led by a facilitator from the UNICA Green & SDGs Working Group to help colleagues understand the purpose of the sessions and the expected outputs and outcomes.

Colleagues are expected to actively participate in the initiative by identifying the subjects to dig in and the format and strategies to do so. Experts on selected topics (academic experts or members who are at a more advanced stage in the road to climate neutrality) can also be invited as mentors. After the 3 sessions, each roundtable is asked to provide a one page summary of key points that can then be shared as a resource with colleagues.

WHO

Vice-Rectors responsible for the implementation of institutional sustainability strategy, Sustainability/ Environmental coordinators from UNICA member universities, members of UNICA Green & SDGs, as well as International Relations Officers and anyone from UNICA members interested in exchanging and learning more on climate action at universities.
