As the European Commission and national research funders throughout Europe are strengthening their Open Science strategies, academic libraries are facing **challenges in supporting the scientific community to meet the Open Science requirements:** negotiating appropriate licenses with publishers in the transition to Open Access, properly managing data, meeting Plan S requirements, dealing with copyright issues. The Seminar will **address issues related to the practical implementation of Open Science strategies and their impact on libraries.**

Questions addressed

- What is the future of scholarly communication beyond transformative agreements?
- What is the impact of Plan S on researchers' publishing practices and on libraries' licensing strategies?
- How to deal with copyright barriers to Open Access?
- What is the role of libraries in EOSC?

Objectives

- Gain insights into the issues at stake related to the strategic approaches to implementing open science.
- Benefit from the experience of others in order to support the academic community in meeting open science challenges.
- Share experiences and views with other colleagues about lessons learnt from the pandemic (Speakers' corner session).
