

☑ Which of the following do you expect the Library to do to support your role as a researcher?






Resume

Lienzos pintados al temple de estilo pompeyano que fueron retirados debido al deterioro producido después de unas inundaciones a finales del siglo XIX. Como ha estudiado Carmen Díaz Gallegos, la mayor concentración de este tipo de lienzos se da en una de las salas, probablemente en la decorada por Luigi Japelli. Dos sobreventanas muestran la danza de unas bacantes y unos amorcillos sobre fondo azul directam publicados en los volúmenes de las Antichità dedicados a las Pinturas, muchas de ellas de la Villa de Cicerón en Pompeya. El mis fragmentos de sobreventanas que se han conservado en peor estado. En el lado Este de la Sala, un gran lienzo mostraba un Cur mientras que una sobrepuerta volvía a incluir a Cupido niño con carcaj y flechas frente a una figura masculina que, de espaldas con su mano izquierda. En otra sobrepuerta se había pintado a Venus sobre una nube junto a Cupido niño. El techo estaba deco motivos florales dentro de recuadros y algunas arquitecturas.

La Segunda Sala o Sala de los emparrados muestra decoraciones florales que recrean abigarrados jardines por los que revolote; peristilos de las casas pompeyanas. En la Sala séptima o egipcia destacan los motivos orientales que se habían puesto de moda, del Templo de Isis pompeyano. Es posible que en el programa iconográfico de esta sala influyese el proyecto de creación de una realizado para la Casita del Príncipe de El Escorial.



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Suggestions from the British Library

- Start small, start now find creative ways to pilot new things
- Reflect, document and share your lessons learned, whether big or small
- Work with partners who can support organisational aims & objectives, e.g. The Carpentries, Wikimedia, Building Library Labs, etc.
- Be as open as possible this will unlock more value to your organisation than anything else you do!
- Harness and celebrate the existing knowledge and skills of staff
- Invest in training staff so that they're more able to collaborate on Digital Humanities projects with others - this investment will be repaid in successful grants and funding bids
- Share what didn't work this can save others time and effort
- Celebrate successes, whether as case studies or stories. The more you can share the words of your collaborators, the more convincing it'll be



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
