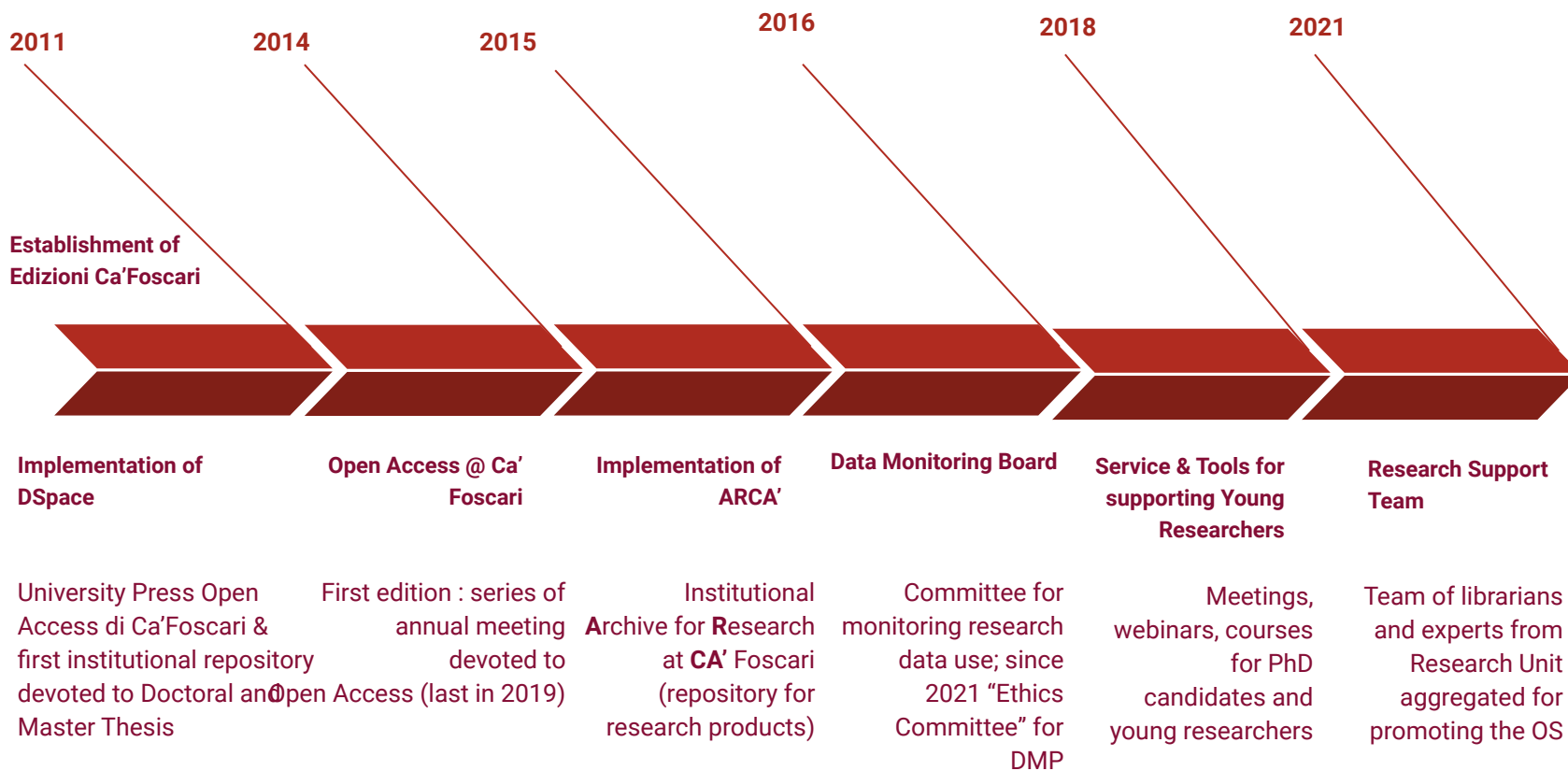

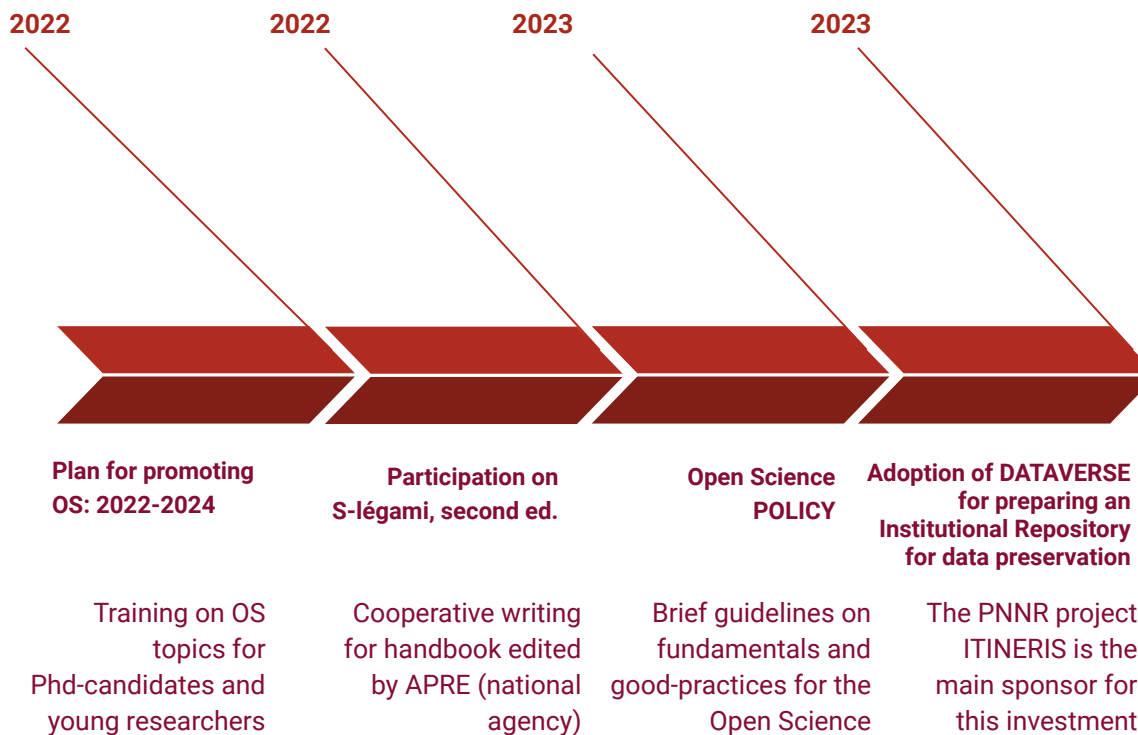

So far the action on Open Science is too much fragmented and the researcher is not "loyal-user"

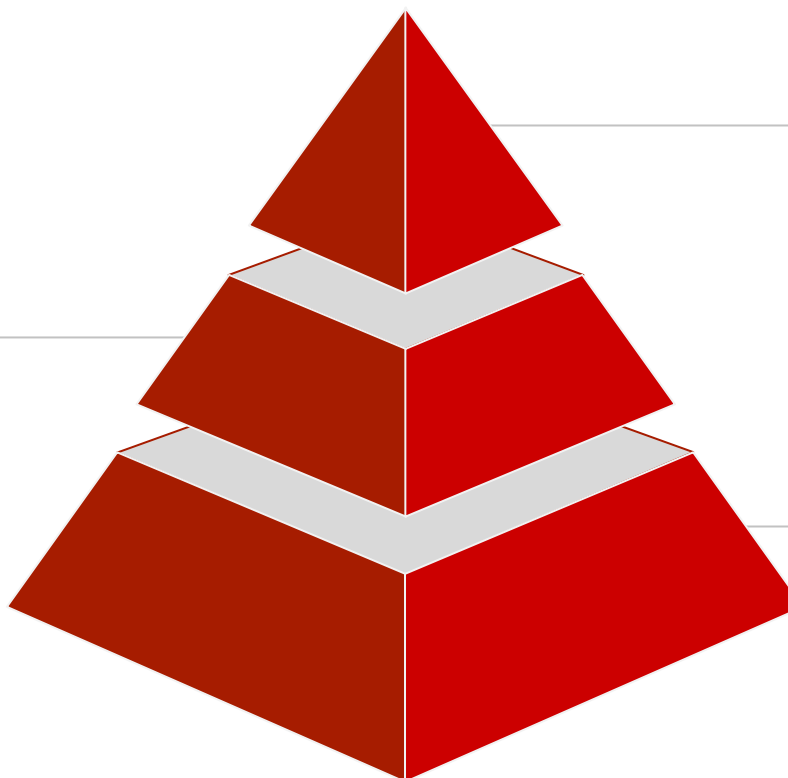
TACTICS VS. STRATEGY
