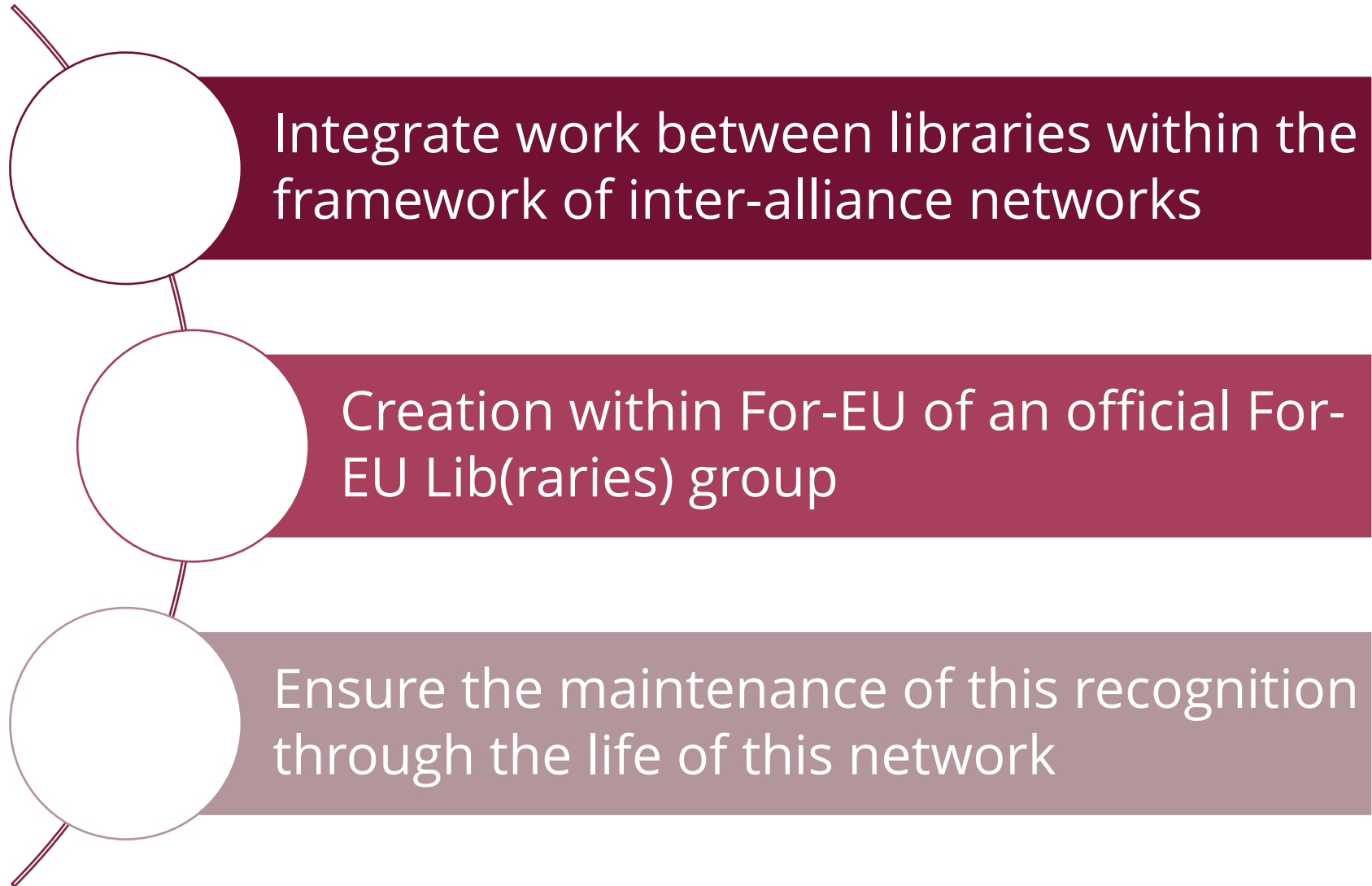
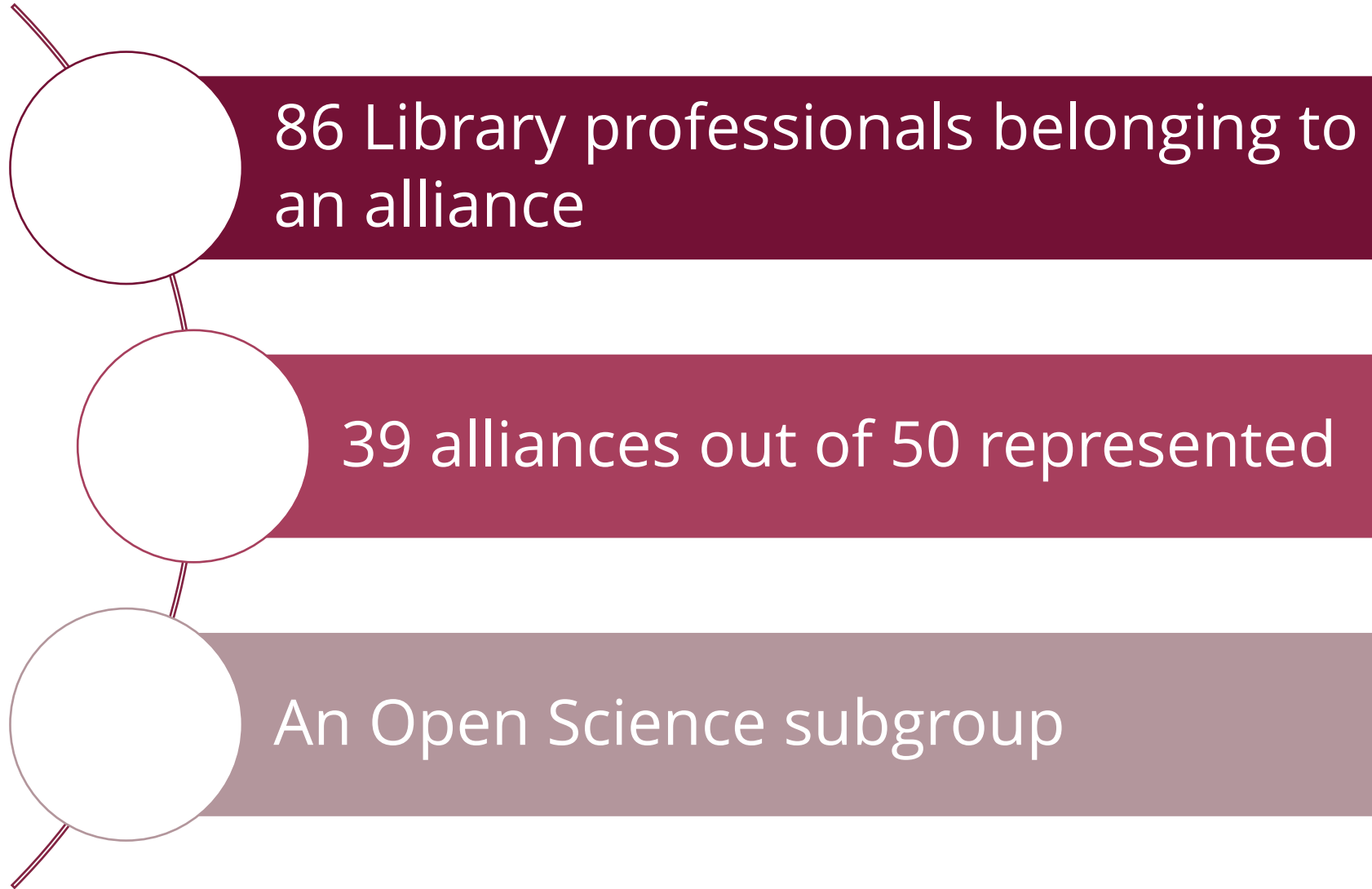


For-EU lib: Encouraging sharing between alliances

For-Eu Lib: Network challenge

Enriching differences

- Varied involvement depending on the waves (pilots, etc.), depending on their position within the governance of the alliances (integration into a WP or a body), depending on the size of the alliance, according to their resources (time, personnel, expertise, linguistic skills)

Sharing of know-how

- Sharing use cases to address common issues from one alliance to another. It's about sharing within the professional community

Be a stakeholder

- Ensure visibility and strengthening in themes for which library professionals have experience and expertise to share. This is to ensure a good understanding of what librarians can bring to the alliances.

For-EU lib Open Science

An European subject

- Open science is intercultural, inter-establishment, within or between alliance players. This implies an ability to decompartmentalize support for science

National or local frameworks

- Each establishment works within a given framework relating to open science, sharing is an opportunity to question or develop this framework through a bottom-up logic.

Synergies

- Despite the constraints, open science practices can gain importance thanks to these European networks (visibility, interdisciplinarity, synergies between the expertise of researchers and research support staff)

For-EU lib Open Science: priorities

Expectations within work packages

- The first objective is to identify and share open science targets within the alliances

Raise awareness and train in open science

- This involves sharing the systems in place and asking very practical questions: efficiency between local action and within the alliance, dissemination and structuring within the alliance, etc.

Driving open science

- Determine and share KPIs.

For-EU lib Open Science: the openings

Science and society/citizen science

- Very present subject in alliances, which opens up prospects for collaboration with other services and enrichment of library practices

Open Data

- Subject less present in alliances initially built around student mobility, growing within the framework of extensions and new waves
