384 students in 20 groups (not BIPs)




Efficient and Student-Centered Program Design

Procurement of transport (if needed)





INTERNATIONALISATION


Bigger number of students can benefit from Erasmus+

ADMINISTRATIVE PRESSURE


Multiple groups in different phases is a burden for E+ officers
