- Letta's report: **"Much more than a market"** April 2024
 - Von Der Leyen's EU Strategic Agenda and **"Europe's Choice: Political guidelines for the next European Commission 2024-2029"** of July 2024
 - Draghi's report: **"The future of European competitiveness"** September 2024
 - Heitor's report: **"Align, act, accelerate - Research, technology and innovation to boost European competitiveness"**, October 2024
 - **Safer Together Niimisto Report** (March 2025)
- **Make business easier and Deepen the Single Market** (Letta Report) (Europe's Choice)
 - **Unlock innovative potentials:** disruptive innovation, new technologies
 - **Rise to the challenge of a new era for European defence and security** (Europe's Choice; Draghi Report)
 - **Defence narrative must consider civilian resilience** (Niimisto report)



An EU Compass to regain competitiveness and secure sustainable prosperity (Jan 2025)

1. Pillar 1: Closing the innovation gap
 - ▶ Only mention of Research in Pillar 1”boost of I&R
 - ▶ No mention of SSH related topics or issues
 - ▶ Keywords: **DEFENCE** and **COMPETITIVENESS** in technological terms
 - ▶ No mention of a self-standing programme for R&I
 - ▶ No mention of ring-fenced budget for R&I
2. Pillar 2: A joint roadmap for decarbonisation and competitiveness
3. Pillar 3: Reducing excessive dependency and increasing security

Keywords: Competitiveness, Defence & Security, ... Democracy

- ▶ **Multi and inter-disciplinarity** : portfolio approach
- ▶ Dialogue: Humanities research results **visibility** (generative AI making discoverable new research in critical areas)
- ▶ Humanities scholars to engage with **policy narratives**
- ▶ Robust **research evaluation** and strengthen multidisciplinary parameters at all levels
- ▶ **Educate** young scholars to engage with multiple approaches (speculations and problem solving, critical thinking but also applied research)
