



Expanding Students' Horizons & Career Opportunities

Careers for Impact: 90-minutes company visits hosted by alumni

- Connects students with alumni working in public policy, NGOs, and international organisations in Berlin and Brussels.
- Helps students explore impactdriven career paths and develop professional skills.
- Opens doors to internships, collaborations, and job opportunities

Policy Sprint: Intensive, practice-driven weekend workshops

- Organized by the Policy Lab and supported by alumni sharing real-world policy and governance challenges.
- Students work in teams to design and test actionable solutions under pressure.
- Alumni provide guidance and feedback

Mentoring Programmes: Personal guidance from those who've walked the same path

- **Connect** students with alumni leaders from diverse sectors.
- Provide guidance on leadership, decision-making, and personal growth.
- Foster reflection, ambition, and a strong sense of belonging.



International Alumni Engagement: Lessons Learnt

- Get to know your international alumni: schedule calls, visits etc. to understand how you can support them and how they can contribute to your institution.
- Set up clear, achievable goals; monitor progress and tweak if needed.
- Work with the leadership on understanding how to best align alumni engagement with other institutional priorities (e.g. student recruitment, fundraising etc.).
- Liase with faculty and other colleagues and encourage them to host alumni meetups as part of their travel whenever possible.
- Define standard practices to thank and recognize alumni volunteers and highlight their impact in the community.
