65 alumni clubs





Understanding who alumni are and what challenges they face is key to creating relevant opportunities.





5. Milestones & Launch of activities



7. Organisational structure



Rectorate – central coordination and support

- Coordinates alumni network
- Manages platform & data
- Organizes monthly meetings & trainings
- Supports faculties & users
- Oversees promotion, mentoring programme, enewsletters

Faculties & Academies – decentralized execution

- 80+ employees who run clubs in addition to regulars work responsibilities
- Communicate with alumni on-line & on campus
- Organize events & mentoring programme

- Alumni Talks (knowledge exchange)






Programs in Practice: Alumni–Student Mentoring



- Enable students to access new forms of informal mentoring, primarily through job shadowing and support during the transition to the workplace.
 Enable alumni to share their experience and knowledge with younger colleagues.
- Mentoring is carried out via an online platform and supported by guidelines available to every mentor and mentee.
- Implementation by members (networking event, alumni picks), support by rectorate.
- 507 mentorship pairs, 759 mentoring connections on the platform.
